The prohibitory liquor law of this State has been on our statute books twenty years. It makes the vending of alcoholic spirits illegal traffic.

Could they obtain the passage of a law which would make the selling of whiskey a crime punishable by imprisonment for life it would be observed not one whit more.

And now it would seem that taxation must needs affect it tantamount in ratio with the tax.

So the \$900 man can sell anything and any quantity of it. The \$200 man can only retail, but his license covers beer, and cider, and the \$100 man must, of course, confine his business to cider etc.

This will certainly put a stop to the little shops at every other door, and hence within bounds it can be regulated to suit the majority.

A Republican County Convention will be held in Grand Rapids on Thursday of next week at 10 o'clock a. m.

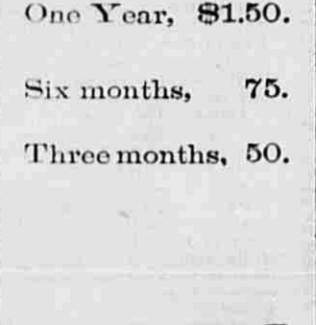

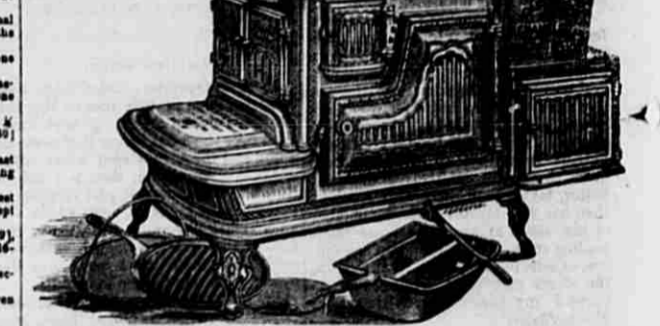
