Several State Legislatures Now in Regular Session.

Woman suffrage popular in Washington Territory—Highway Young's Nephew Down on Polygamy—Colored Voters' Demands—Other Notes.

THE FIELD OF POLITICS.

DETROIT, Mich., Jan. 12.—The State Central Committee of the Union Labor party of Michigan met here Tuesday and decided to call a convention to select delegates to the National Convention at Lansing May 23. The club system of organization was adopted. A committee was appointed to meet the United Labor party of the State with a view to harmony.

ANNAPOLIS, Md., Jan. 12.—Hon. Eliza E. Jackson was inaugurated Governor of Maryland yesterday in the presence of both Houses of the General Assembly.

LEICESTER, Ky., Jan. 12.—At noon yesterday the two Houses of the Kentucky Legislature in session elected Hon. James R. Beck for a third successive term in the United States Senate.

PENDLETON, Ore., Jan. 13.—The Oregon Democrats will hold their state convention in this city April 3 next.

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind., Jan. 13.—The Democratic State Editorial Association of Indiana met in this city yesterday and elected Daniel McDonald, of the Plymouth Democrat, president for the ensuing year.

DES MOINES, Ia., Jan. 13.—Governor William Latta was inaugurated for a second term yesterday afternoon. In his inaugural address he strongly combated the doctrine of free trade and urged the necessity of protecting American labor manufactures. On the question of railroad transportation the Governor took decided ground, urged remedial legislation, favored the power of the national commissioners, and giving to them authority to fix rates and enforce their decisions. The question of prohibition was briefly referred to.

HAYES ROCKS, Ia., Jan. 13.—Francis T. Nichols was yesterday nominated for Governor by the Democratic State convention.

JACKSON, Miss., Jan. 14.—The Democrats of the Legislature yesterday renominated E. C. Wallhall for United States Senator.

SPRINGFIELD, Ill., Jan. 14.—The colored people of Springfield, in an address to the party demand that the Republicans give the colored voters a representative on the State ticket. They claim that the colored people cast 18,000 votes in the State and are a necessary part of its success. They present the name of Samuel V. Casey, of this city, for Lieutenant-Governor.

RICHMOND, Va., Jan. 14.—Mr. Anderson, one of the members of the Virginia Legislature, has introduced a bill to grant a pension of \$30 per year to all Virginia soldiers, sailors and marines who were disabled during the war, and the same amount to widows of those killed in the Confederate service.

AKRON, N. Y., Jan. 17.—Senator Cantor has introduced in the New York Senate providing for a comprehensive system of enlarging and improving the State canal system. It appropriates \$1,000,000 to be used with, and continues expending five times as much. If carried into effect it will greatly lessen the cost of conveying grain from the West to New York by water.

NEW ORLEANS, La., Jan. 17.—The contest of Nichols' success in the coming election will be the election by the next Legislature, to meet in May next, of Senator Cantor for another term and the retirement of Senator East to finish up this body having both Senatorships to fill.

REMARK, D. T., Jan. 17.—Governor Church has at last issued a proclamation giving the official results of the recent election on the division of the Territory. The total number of votes cast was 67,419; 37,781 for division, and 29,638 against. The result, barring a few scattering votes, gives a majority for division of 4,781. Local option was carried in six-four out of the eighty-six counties.

SPRINGFIELD, Ill., Jan. 17.—An election in the Thirteenth Judicial District on February 7 was ordered yesterday by Governor Cantor to fill the vacancy occasioned by the death of Judge John V. Easton.

TACOMA, W. T., Jan. 17.—Both branches of the Legislature of Washington Territory have re-elected the same Senators, but exempted women from jury service.

DES MOINES, Ia., Jan. 17.—At a caucus of Democratic members of the Legislature last night T. J. Anderson was nominated for United States Senator.

SALT LAKE CITY, U. T., Jan. 17.—A bill was introduced in the Legislature yesterday by John M. Young, a nephew of the late Brigham Young, to suppress the practice of polygamy.

HAIKAL, N. S., Jan. 17.—Jeffrey McColl, a member of the Legislature in speech advocated the immediate abolition of local legislatures and the annexation of Nova Scotia to the United States.
