**POLITICAL POINTERS.**

Interesting News from Various Portions of the Country.

**The Democratic Congressional Committee—**Preparing for the Republican National Convention—The Labor Party—Other Notes.

**AMONG THE POLITICIANS.**

**SAN FRANCISCO, Feb. 8.**—A number of prominent Republicans met in this city yesterday and organized the Republican State Club of California. W. B. L. Barnes was elected president.

**NEW YORK, Feb. 9.**—The Anti-Monopoly League, of which W. A. Carsey is head, has issued a call for a National convention, to be held in this city on August 1 next.

**WASHINGTON, Feb. 10.**—The caucus of the Democratic members of the House Wednesday afternoon for the purpose of selecting representatives on the Democratic Congressional Committee resulted in the choice of the following named persons:

**TOLSON, Kan., Feb. 10.**—A convention was held here yesterday which organized the Henry George United Labor party in Kansas. Delegates were present from all parts of the State. The platform adopted at the Syracuse convention was adopted entire, and it was decided to put a full ticket in the field this year.

**NEW YORK, Feb. 10.**—Despite the fact that Henry George has declared against the nomination of an independent candidate for the Presidency by the United Labor party this year and announced his preference for Mr. Cleveland, it is altogether likely that the party will put a candidate in nomination. This opinion is advanced by labor leaders.

**NASHVILLE, Tenn., Feb. 10.**—The Republicans of Tennessee will hold their State convention in this city on May 16 next to elect delegates to the National convention.

**JACKSON, Mich., Feb. 10.**—The State convention of Republicans to elect delegates to the National convention will be held in this city April 4.

**CHICAGO, Feb. 11.**—The Republican subcommittee of the National Committee, who were in this city yesterday arranging the preliminary details for the National convention, chose General Fitz-Simons for sergeant-at-arms, and Mayor Roche as chairman of the Finance and Finance Committee. Mr. Clarkson, chairman of the subcommittee, said he had already received over 2,000 applications for tickets. The hall will seat 7,500 persons, and that number of tickets will be issued.

**ANNAPOLIS, Md., Feb. 13.**—A bill has been introduced in the Legislature making it a penalty for registered voters to fail to vote.

**NEW YORK, Feb. 13.**—Henry George resists any thing whatever to say in regard to the attacks made on him by prominent members of the United Labor party. He declined to say any thing about his relations with Dr. McMillan or the Labor party. The effect of the split is that there are two factions being formed out of the party which cast 73,000 votes for Henry George last November. One will follow Dr. McMillan and the other will support Henry George. The Anti-Poverty Society will also be dragged into the fight.

**MADISON, Wis., Feb. 14.**—A convention of Republican clubs for the formation of a State League will be held in this city on March 15.

**COLUMBUS, O., Feb. 14.**—A banquet of Republican League clubs was held in this city last evening. All the prominent Republican leaders in the State were present.

**DANON, Me., Feb. 14.**—Republicans will meet in State convention in this city on April 26 to nominate Presidential electors and delegates to the National convention at Chicago.

**Prohibition in Iowa.**

**DES MOINES, Ia., Feb. 8.**—At the twelfth annual meeting in this city yesterday of the Iowa Temperance Alliance the secretary stated that eight of the judges reported crime licensed by the Prohibition law; seventy-one counties reported the law in force and fourteen said it was a failure; the effect in business was said to be good by twenty-one reports and bad by two, and twenty-four sessions were reported to be in operation, against three thousand when the law was passed.

**Want Indian Territory Opened.**

**KANSAS CITY, Mo., Feb. 9.**—A large meeting was held here yesterday to take steps with a view to securing Congressional action on the movement in favor of opening the Indian Territory to settlement. A permanent organization was effected, with Governor Morehouse, of Missouri, as president, and a committee of fifteen was appointed to present a memorial to Congress and impress upon the members thereof the necessity of speedy action.

**A Suicide at Seven.**

**BOSTON, Feb. 9.**—The suicide of Jenny Barker by shooting at Brookline, is remarkable from the youth of the victim. Jenny was not 7 years of age. Her mother died at the time of her birth. A few years later her father married again, and it is charged that the affection between the child and her step-mother developed into an abnormality in the girl's character which led to the suicide.

**In Memory of General Logan.**

**WASHINGTON, Feb. 11.**—The sixty-second anniversary of the birthday of the late Senator Logan was commemorated last evening by the dedication of a memorial tablet in the Metropolitan Methodist Episcopal Church in this city, which the Senator was in the habit of attending.

**Seven Men to Hang.**

**FORT SMITH, Ark., Feb. 10.**—In the United States Court here yesterday Judge Parker sentenced Owen D. Hill, George Moss, Jeff Hildebrand, Emanuel Patterson, Richard Sutherland, Jack Crow and William Alexander to be hanged on April 27 for murder.

**A Murderer Executed.**

**UTICA, N. Y., Feb. 10.**—Clement A. Day was hanged here yesterday. He was convicted of the murder of his mistress, Johanna Rose Crow, in June last, of whom he was insanely jealous.

**Given Up as Lost.**

**PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 9.**—The British steamship Albatross, of the London and New York line, was given up as lost with her crew, numbering eighty men.
