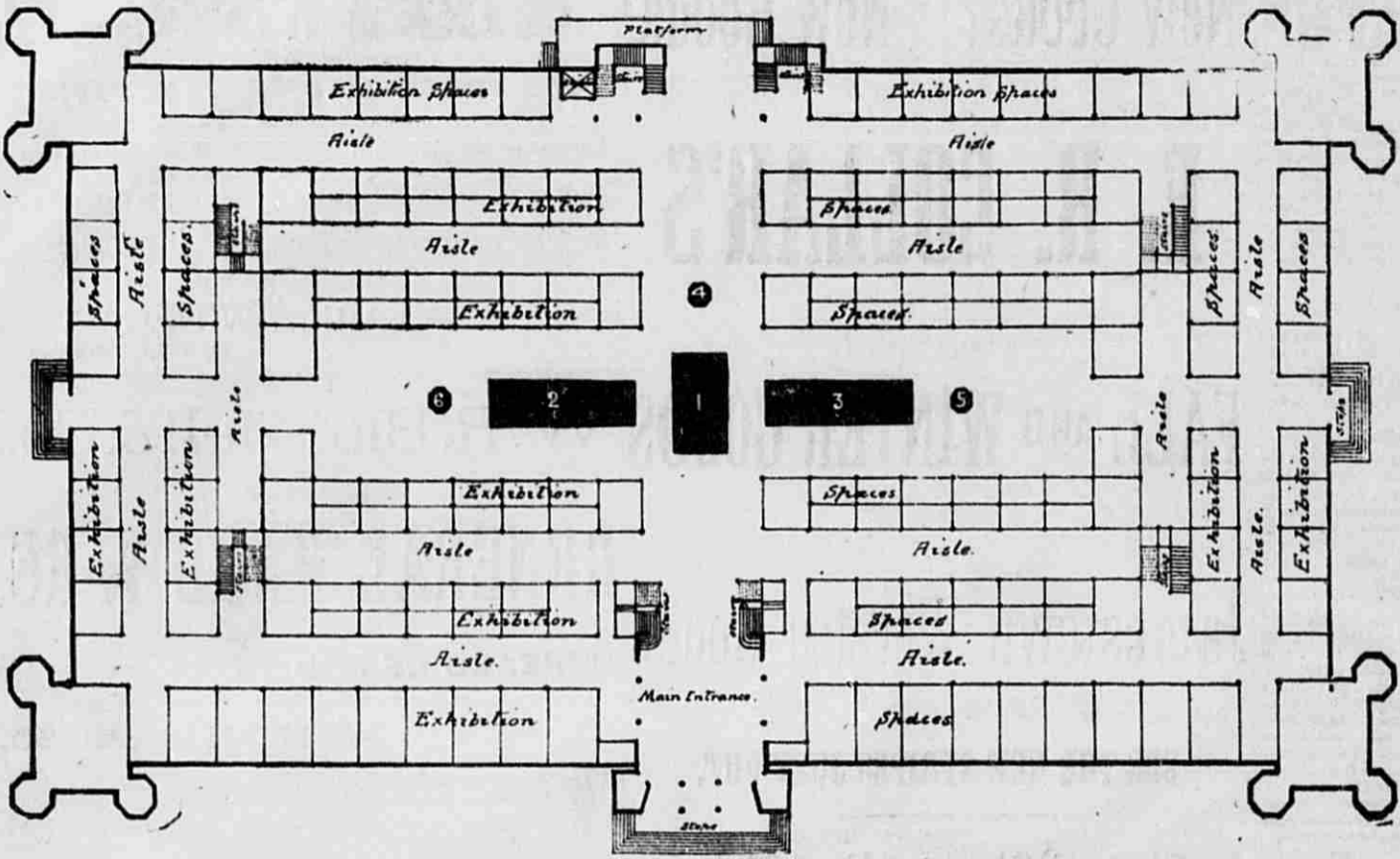


PLAN OF GROUND FLOOR MAIN BUILDING, DETROIT EXPOSITION.
