

STATE NEWS.

Silver ore worth \$500,000 has been shipped from the Lake Superior mines the present summer.

Owing to the drought, in the Grand Traverse County, meadows of hay were hardly worth cutting the present season.

The amount of wool purchased in Ann Arbor the present year is only \$20,000 pounds, and is said to fall far short of the amount purchased in previous years.

General G. D. Hill, of Ann Arbor, has just completed his new Opera House in that city. The building cost \$40,000; and is to be opened about the 1st of August.

The Pomological Hall is now being erected on the fair grounds at Grand Rapids, and it is said will be the largest building ever erected in Michigan for the display of fruit.

The East Shore News notes a case of severe poisoning occasioned by handling potato bugs. The victim has for a long time been obliged to carry the affected hand in a sling.

Hon. Geo. C. Bates of Chicago, formerly of this State, and a well known lawyer, has tendered his gratuitous services to Vanderpool, in case his recent counsel do not continue in the case.

He did so, and at the first turn drew the old lady's skeleton completely and entirely from her body, leaving her a mass of quivering jelly in the chair. Tushmaker took her home in a pillow case. She lived seven years after that, and they called her the "India-rubber woman." She had suffered terribly with the rheumatism but after this occurrence never had any pain in her bones. The dentist kept them in a glass case.

Afterwards this machine was sold to the contractor of the Boston Custom House, and it was found that a child three years of age could, by a single turn of the screw raise a stone weighing twenty-five tons.

Smaller ones were made on the same principle, and sold to the keepers of hotels and restaurants. They were used for boning turkeys.

There is no moral at all to this story and it is possible that the circumstances may have become slightly exaggerated. Of course there can be no doubt of the main incidents.
