Plans are set for Lowell's annual "Fourth of July Celebration" to be staged here Monday. The schedule of events is a mile long, but this article will attempt to run down all the day's events anyway. ## Posthumus fights for more state aid

State Senator Dick Posthumus continued his fight for a higher priority on state education funding during Senate passage of the K-12 school aid budget for fiscal 1983-84.

Posthumus offered an amend ment that would increase the school aid budget to at least 18 percent of the total state revenue in 1985, 19 percent in 1986, and 20 percent by the year 1987. The measure fell just short of passage during debate

"I was disappointed th amendement did not pass," Post humus said after the vote. "Edu cation is the best investment the state can make in its future."

"For instance, the K-12 school district funding has droppe from 29% to 16% in the curren school year. As a result the local taxpayer has been forced to shoulder higher millages and higher property valuations to offset the state's shift in funding

priorities. "It is time we realized that to assure a brighter future for Michigan we must simply move education to the top of our fund ing priorities and keep it there. Posthumus concluded.


