## Lowell officer fatally shoots knife weilding assailant

Lowell police officer Calvin Kamphuis, and finally stabbing did not find anyone on the scene him in the arm with a knife, 27 year old James Michael Pfaff the chest from Kamphuis' service revolver. The shooting occurred at 3:40 A.M. on Monday, July 4 on Lowell's Main St. in front of Larkin's Saloon. Kamphuis, an 8 year veteran of the force, had responded to a com-

# Lowell's 'Fourth' is a huge success

One of the highlights of Lowell's day-long Fourth of July festivities was the Lowell Showboat drawing for a 1983 Chevrolet Camaro. At about 9:00 Lowell Mayor Dean Collins pulled the winning tickets from the 2,675 tickets in the hopper. The grand prize winner was Edward Straub of Struthers, Ohio. Straub purchased his winning ticket from raffle chairman Roger Brown back in March when the car was on display at a Corvette swap meet at the Kalamazoo county Fairgrounds. The second prize of \$1,000 went to Lowell Showboat Captain Barry Vezino on a ticket that he had purchased that day. The third prize \$500 was won by Gerald Garner of Grant, Michigan on a ticket he purchased from Dick Huver of Lowell. They are co-workers at Lear Siegler.

In all, \$26,750 in ticket sales were generated, and the budget on the drawing was kept at or near \$3,500, thanks in part to Showboat President Ray Quada not claiming the \$250 prize for sold 504 tickets in all.
