# **Board pleased with student basic skills tests**

fourth, seventh, and tenth grade classes demonstrated excellent results on the 1986 Michigan to the Lowell Board of Educa-Educational Assessment Program tests. This year 193 tenth, 178 seventh, and 179 fourth graders were tested by the now famil- noted that 1980 was the base year iar MEAP tests which have been administered to pubic school children since 1969. The overall scores showed some slight declines from last year, but those declines were very minimal. In general, over 90% of the fourth and seventh graders and 75% of the tenth graders achieved at least 75% of the objectives in mathematics. In reading, student scores were also very high with 95% of the seventh graders, 88% of the fourth graders, and 78%

"The excellent scores are due in part to the direct involvement of teachers and administrators in curriculum development and the emphasis we place on teaching the basic skills," said Dr. Esch.

There is now an effort underway to produce tests for other academic areas. The State Board of Education is taking a giant

step in the direction of measuring the achievement of minimal competencies in areas other than the "basics" of the math and reading. This year, all school districts were given a new test to measure basic knowledge in science. As with most other districts, Lowell's scores in all three measured levels were lower than their read-

Chris VanAntwerp, Board President, noted the Board's pleasure with the detailed report and especially the improved scores. "I am pleased with the scores recently reported to the Lowell Area Schools as the results of administering the MEAP Test to our 4th, 7th, and 10th graders. These scores show that our administrators, teachers, and students are doing an excellent job of stressing the basic instruction in reading and math. I feel the students in the Lowell Area

#### **OVERSEAS CHRISTMAS MAILING DATES**

Lowell Postamster Charlie Doyle has passed along a postal bulletin regarding mailing dates for overseas parcels intended for Christmas delivery. Military priority mail and letters may be mailed to even the most remote places, such as Southeast Asia, Australia and South America as late as November 24. Mail to Alaska, Hawaii and the Caribbean will still arrive by Christmas if mailed as late as December 8. Military air parcels should be going out soon. For instance, air parcels to the mideast should have gone out November 3, while parcels to Alaska can go out as late as December 1. Space available air parcels take a little longer. Many deadlines for parcels travelling surface routes have already passed.

International Mail deadlines are about the same. Air parcel deadlines for remote areas begin on November 24, and all parcels should be mailed prior to December 5, with the lone exception of December 12 for the Caribbean. Airmail letters and cards have about the same guidelines. Surface parcel deadlines have already passed.







**Obituaries** 



Constipation is a symptom, not a disease. It is defined as a decrease in the frequency of bowel movements, accompanied by prolonged or difficult passage of stools. There is no accepted rule for the correct number of daily or weekly bowel movements. "Regularity" maybe a twice-daily bowel movement for some or two bowel movements a week for others.

If you become constipated, you should first see your doctor to rule out a more serious problem. If the results show that no intestinal disease or abnormality exists and your doctor approves, try one of these remedies:

--Eat more fresh fruits and vegetables, either cooked or raw, and more whole grain cereals and breads. Dried fruits such as apricots, prunes, and figs are especially high in fiber. Try to cut back on highly processed foods (such as sweets) and food high in

--Drink plenty of liquids (1 or 2 quarts daily) unless you have heart, circulatory or kidney problems. But beware that some people become consitipated from drinking large quantities of milk.

--Add small amounts of unprocessed bran (Miller's Bran -- usually sold in health food stores) to baked goods, cereals, and fruits as a way of increasing the fiber content of the diet. --Stay active. Even taking a brisk walk after dinner can help

tone your muscles. -- Try to develop a regular bowel habit. If you have had problems

breakfast or dinner.

--Avoid taking laxatives if at all possible. Although they will usually relieve the constipation, you can quickly come to depend on them, and the natural muscle actions required for defecation will be impaired --Limit your intake of antacids, as some can cause constipation.

as well as other health problems. Above all, do not expect to have a bowel movement every day or every other day. "Regularity" differs from person to person. If your bowel movements are usually painless and occur regularly, then you are probably not constipated.

## Natural storage of garden harvest

Using the natural environment to store food has become almost a lost art. Before the advent of freezers and refrigerators, many foods that weren't canned or available year round were simply stored in the home until needed.

Successful storage does not involve a large investment or loads of equipment. It requires only an awareness of the temperature and humidity required for successful storage of various crops and some materials and maintenance to assist natural conditions.

Late-maturing varieties of fruits and vegetables are best suited for home storage.

Vegetables and fruits that are stored properly remain dormant and do not complete their natural cycle of decomposition. Any that do spoil pose no hidden danger because you can tell by the look and smell if the food has spoiled.

Some vegetables require a moist environment while others equire a dry one. Some need to be kept cool, some warm. Such vegetables as beets, car-

rots, horseradish, leeks and parsnips require cold, moist surroundings. They can be stored right in the garden throughout the winter. Mark the location and mulch with sawdust or some other insulating material to maintain uniform temperature, and keep the soil from freezing so you can harvest your crops all

A storage mound or pit is an appropriate place to store cabbage and root crops. Place it in a well-drained area and line it with insulating material such as straw, dry leaves or soil. Cover the mound with more insulating material and then a layer of soil.

A cool, dark spot in the basement may be ideal for some foods. If your basement is cool and dry, you can store onions, garlic and peppers. A cool, moist basement would be well suited for storing potatoes, tomatoes and pears.

Containers and shelves built to hold fruits and vegetables should have slats to permit air circulation. Temperature and humidity should be monitored and pro-

duce checked regularly for spoil-

Lowell defeated the Portland Raiders Friday night to extend their overall record to 5-4.


