AGGREGATES \$200,000

That's What the County Budget Looks Like

With the adoption of the report of the finance committee by the board of supervisors the items contained in the budget as it now stands will reach \$210,742.50. It is the opinion of the committee that the sum of \$200,000 will be sufficient to meet the operating expenses of the county for the ensuing year and a recommendation of this character is contained in the report. The sum of \$5,000 has been cut from the salary item, \$1,000 from the stationery and expense account, \$1,000 from the insane asylum expense, \$1,000 from the jail fund and \$1,000 from the juvenile home fund. Among the larger items added are \$20,000 as a sinking fund and \$1,800 interest on bonds. The state tax amounts to \$554,353.37. The report provides for a levy of one-third of a mill for the soldiers' relief fund.—[Press.


