





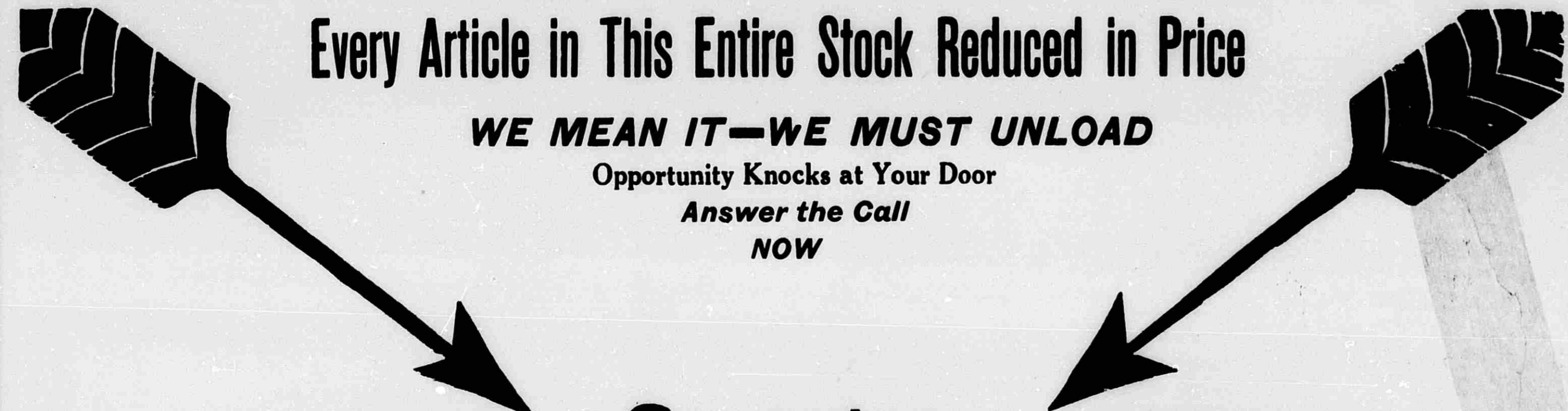

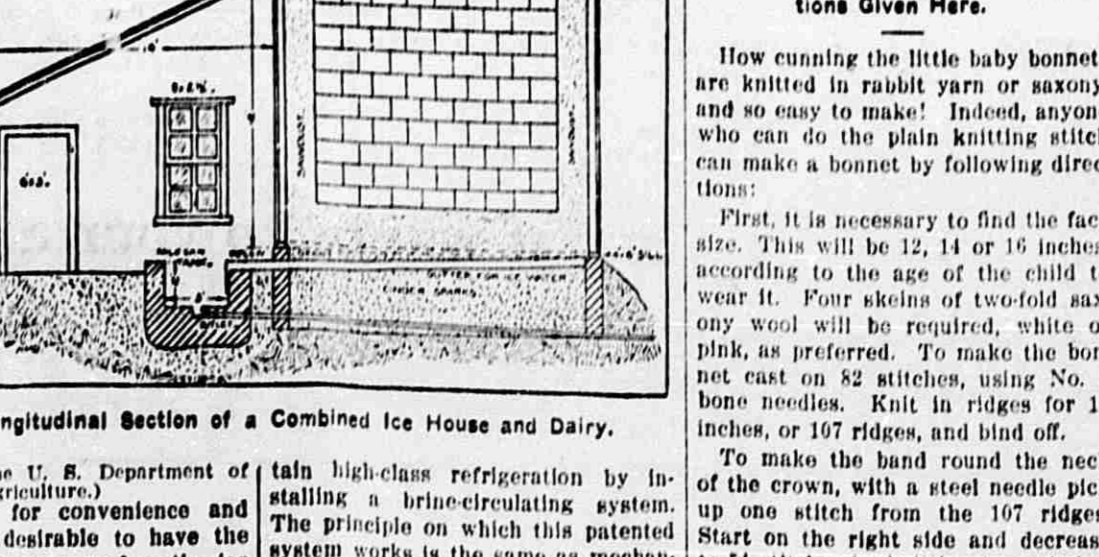


Fig. 1—Longitudinal Section of a Combined Ice House and Dairy. Fig. 2—Transverse Section of a Combined Ice House and Dairy.

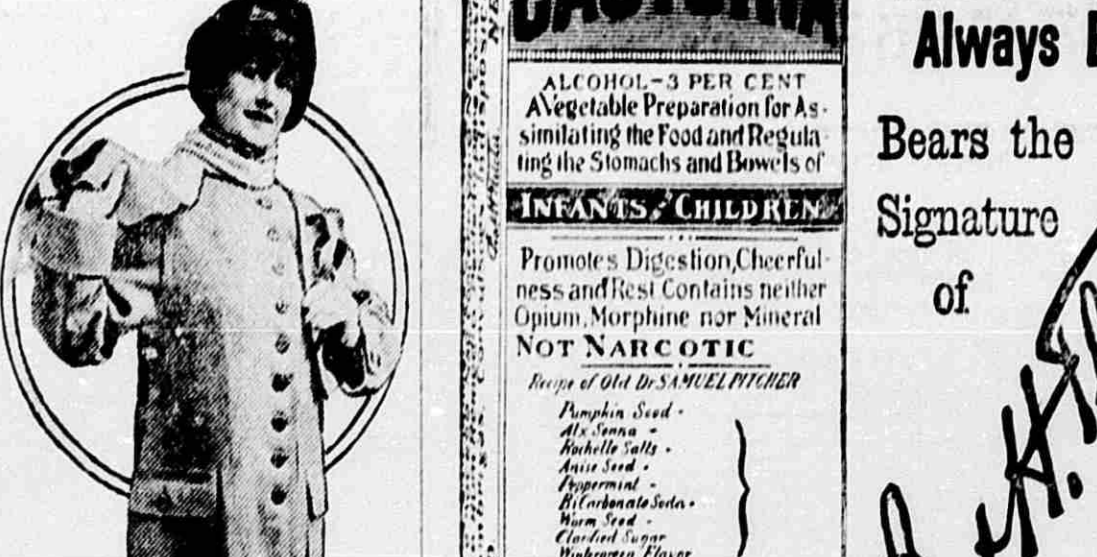
Fig. 3—Diagram Showing a Combined Ice House and Cold-Storage Plant. The diagram shows the layout of the ice house, refrigerator, and cold storage plant.
