WOODROW WILSON, OUTSTANDING FIGURE OF THE AGE

Remarkable Career of the Man Who, After Gaining Fame as an Educator and Author, Became President, and During the Great War Was the Most Powerful Individual in the World—Originator of the League of Nations.

Woodrow Wilson, twenty-eight years of age, when he was elected president of the United States in 1912, was the most prominent figure of the events growing out of the World War, the most prominent of all wars. His place as a historical figure is one that will never be surpassed if ever attained by any man in history.

It is impossible now to differentiate between Woodrow Wilson the man and Woodrow Wilson the head of the most powerful nation of earth. The material and fighting men certainly could not have reached the place of honor which Woodrow Wilson has held without great ability and extraordinary capacity for leadership.

Woodrow Wilson was born December 28, 1856, in Staunton, Va. He was the son of Rev. Joseph R. Wilson, a Presbyterian minister, and Jessie Woodrow Wilson, nee Estlin (Mrs. H. Sayre). Eleanor (Mrs. W. G. M. Adair) and Margaret, Mrs. Wilson died August 10, 1914. Mrs. Wilson was born December 18, 1915. Mr. Wilson married Edith Bolling Galt, a descendant of President James M. Buchanan, in 1885. Her father was 23 years of age when she was born.

Mr. Wilson was elected to Congress in 1882. He served in the House from 1882 to 1885. He was elected to the Senate in 1890 and served until 1897. He was elected Governor of New Jersey in 1901 and served until 1906. He was elected President in 1912 and served until 1921.
