LOWELL CHICK HATCHERY NOW OPERATING—STEP-MOTHER COVERS 45,000 EGGS AT A SETTING.

Professor Foreman reports a very promising outlook for the success of his chick hatchery established in Lowell. Orders have been received by him from nearly every State east of the Rocky Mountains and from three Canadian Provinces.

The incubators installed in the Foreman hatchery are of the electric type being heated and operated entirely by electricity. Each machine represents a hatching capacity of 15,000 eggs and the three units now installed give a combined capacity of 45,000 eggs at each setting.

The electric incubators are now recognized as the leading machine on the market for economy of operation and actual hatching results.


