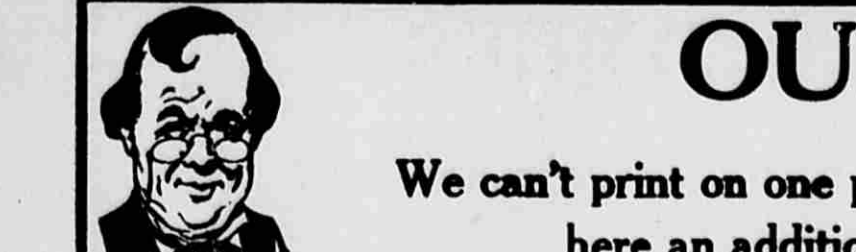

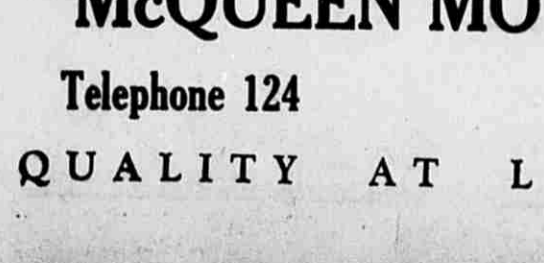
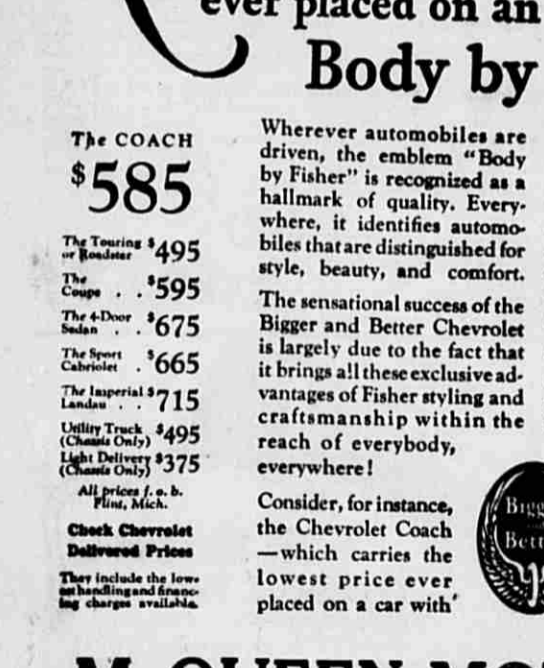

LOWELL DOCTOR WRITES FROM SUMMERLAND

(Continued From First Page.) Since we are to stay in this Marine hotel a month I might say that my first impression is very satisfactory.

After lunch we drove by the house in which George Washington, with his brother Lawrence, who had consumption, stayed during the winter of 1751. They were British subjects at that time. Washington was taken sick with smallpox. The brother Lawrence died the next year, and left George the property, Mount Vernon, near Washington, D. C.

A drive around this island makes one certain that the main industry is producing sugar, one sees nothing but sugar cane in all stages of development. The negroes eat it as part of their food.

It takes 18 months from planting to harvesting, only the stalk is used at the mills, the leaves are burned and fed to the stock, or decomposed for fertilizer. Land here sells for \$100 to \$300 per acre, depending on fertility or distance from market. No land to speak of is owned by the laborers.

Sunday morning, Feb. 5, 1928, temperature 80, gentle, warm, balmy breeze, sky cloudless, air soft and lovely. We took a bus to Lane's bathing beach. The bus carried about twenty people, was open on four sides, filled indiscriminately with blacks and whites, there was no distinction. Fare is about two cents a mile, very reasonable, while auto and carriage fare is 50 cents a mile, costs six cents going in to Bridgetown on the bus, \$1.50 by auto. The roads are made of crushed coral rock, and are pure white, some bumpy in places, all the island roads are constructed of this material.

Layne's beach is a stretch of ocean about a mile long with a sand beach, no rocks for a quarter of a mile out, a beautiful bottom, a bit farther out a line of coral rocks, or reefs, protects this beautiful spot, like a fence, from big waves and dangerous fish, (Barracuda and sharks.) Along the whole shore there are enormous grape trees, whose protecting shade is very welcome after a time of wave jumping.

Here on Sunday morning it is the custom for the negroes to give their burros a weekly bath. Did you ever see two negro boys try to lead an objecting donkey? Pull, jerk, use the stick, then turn him around and try to back him into the water, no good. It was a small donkey, not much larger than a full sized goat, I thought they ought to carry him in, but no, ultimately, one darker pulled the other took a hind leg over his shoulder, and the obstinate beast had his bath. We heard there was to be a band concert at 5 o'clock p. m. So we went to hear it. Arriving at Queen's we were surprised at the size of both park and crowd. There were 1,500 or 2,000, people. A band of 80 pieces, all negroes, playing classical music too, and doing it very well. Astonished too, we were, after being there half an hour, we realized that we were almost the only whites present. We saw but two others, old ladies, in an old fashioned carriage, one horse, with a coachman, a darky dressed in uniform, high silk tite, mounted on a high box seat in front of them.

I never saw colored people so well dressed as this crowd. There were flappers, dressed exactly like our flappers at home, no long dresses here, silk stockings, and everything all spotlessly clean, children of all ages and shades of color from coal black to light brown, in numbers like the sands on the shore. Black policemen in English uniform, trimmed with bright red were much in evidence everywhere. I never saw a more orderly, nicer acting crowd, no noisy laughter, every one was on his Sunday best. I saw him to match his Sunday clothes. All well, Best wishes, S. S. LEE.

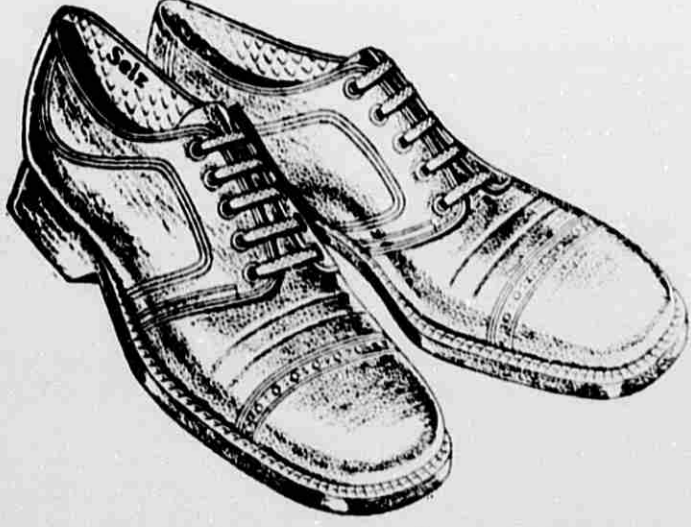
