NEW YORK... Market Cholesterol (above), French corn shovels, Upon arrival he showed ship was in a job of getting down.



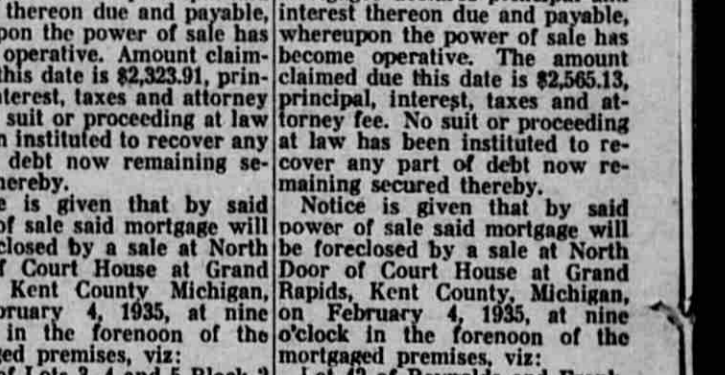

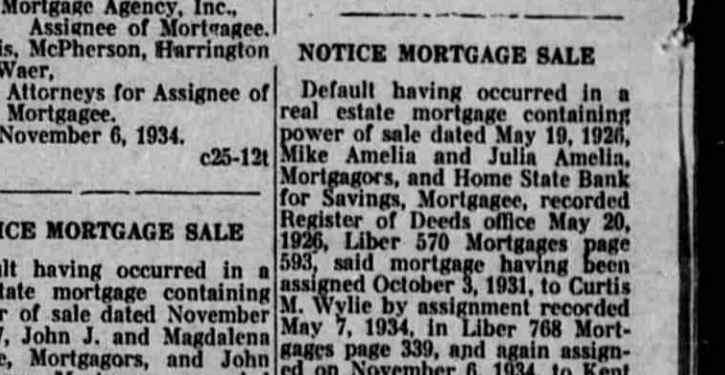
