Patrons Interested In School Proposal

Board of Education Presents the Details in Concise Statement

Since announcement was made in last week's Ledger that the federal government had approved the application for an addition to the central school building, patrons throughout the district have been showing much interest in the matter...

The Board of Education believes that the existing facilities for the education of our children are inadequate. The Board is convinced that the best interests of the children demand an addition to the Central plant, present and future needs could be met by an addition of a suitable gymnasium and six additional classrooms.

The total cost of the project would be \$70,000. Of this amount the Federal Government would make an outright grant of \$31,000. The district would have to issue bonds for \$39,000.

The Virginia or white-tailed deer, the moose and the elk are the only members of the deer family in Michigan.

### WHY Sailors Were Given the Name of "Jack Tar"

A waterproof canvas impregnated with tar is called a tarpaulin. By extension the wide-brimmed storm hat formerly worn by sailors was called tarpaulin also. Generally these hats were made of oiled or tarred cloth. As time went on the sailors themselves came to be called tarpaulins. The word was applied to sailors by Charles Dickens, and by many other writers. Finally it was shortened into "tar" and the "Jack" supplied to make the name picturesque. The popular belief that a sailor is called a tar because of the practice of using tar to seal the seams of a ship apparently is disproved by the fact that sailors were called tarpaulins before they were called tars.

### Why British Barristers Still Don Their Black Gowns

Do you know why barristers wear black gowns?  
The reason is that members of the bar went into mourning at the death of Queen Anne in 1714, and as Queen Anne is still dead, so barristers continue to mourn.

According to the King James version of the Bible, the last part of Genesis, 14:20 reads: "He gave him tithes of all." John Wycliffe translated this passage, "He gave him dimes of all things." The United States ten-cent piece was called a dime because it represented the tenth part of a dollar, the national monetary unit.
