The Family and American Democracy

(The 20th in a series of articles sponsored by the Lowell Child Study Club.) Above all, the right kind of discipline leads to the child's self-discipline. This is the end and aim of all discipline of the right kind.

Discipline that leads to self-discipline teaches self-control and self-respect, and the development of the ability to take on responsibilities in the home without being told. In other words, discipline should develop an inner conviction, I should.

Discipline is really, and should always be considered thus, a means to self-discipline. It is a method of teaching self-discipline and self-respect in the child. Requiring obedience blindly, simply for obedience's sake, is a life-long 'I ought'—creates the rebel, the anti-authority adult.

The war, with its necessary military demands, has raised again the old question of whether blind, unquestioning obedience is not, after all, perhaps the right answer. It is what Burton K. Fowler, principal of Germantown Friends' School says on this matter, "Obedience is 'American parents, it must be admitted, have never done a particularly good job of teaching their children either the blind or of the enlightened sort—at least not as good a job as we could have done in the light of our new knowledge of child development and education."
