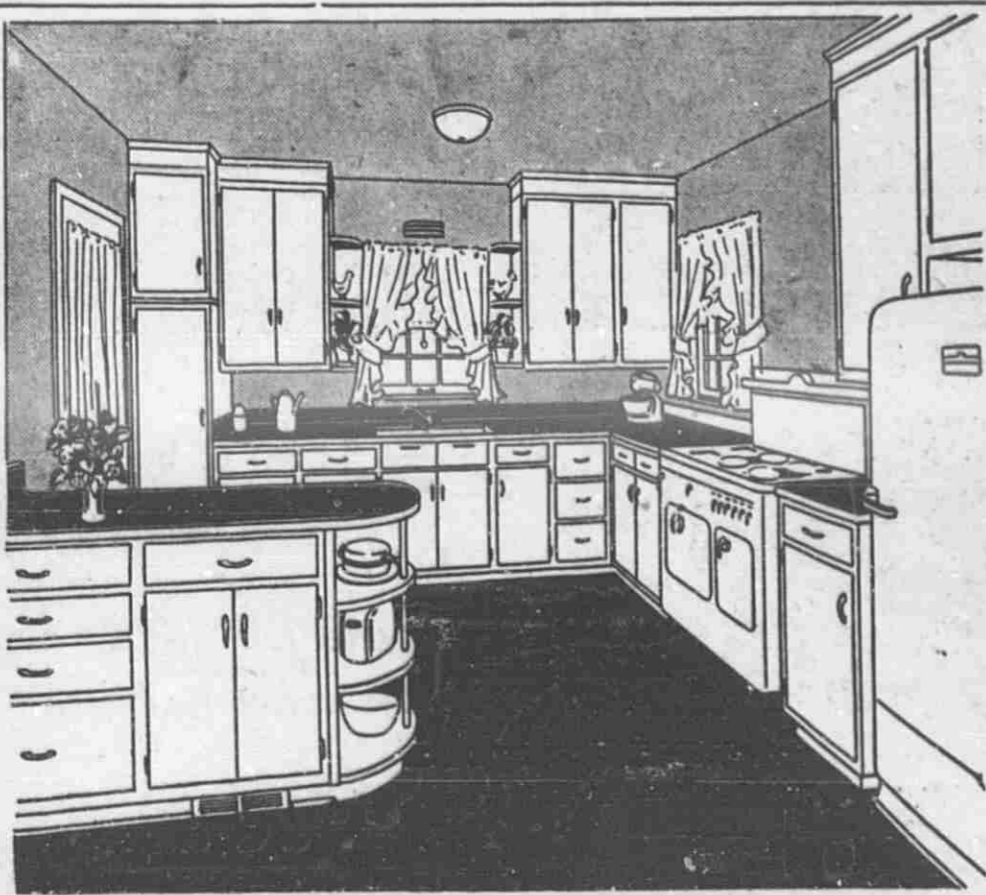

Many Bureaus Overlap Says Michigan's Little Hoover Commission

Much is being said about the Hoover Commission, and the "Little Hoover Commission" which tries to do for Michigan what the Hoover Commission is attempting to accomplish in Washington.

Attorney Ed McCobb, president of the Grand Rapids Chamber of Commerce, who recently spoke before the Lowell Rotary club, is a member of Michigan's Little Hoover Commission and in his address he stated the chief objective is to streamline government functioning to reduce the cost and the taxpayers' load. The plan is non-political, both parties claim to favor it, but the pressure groups do not.

About half of Hoover's report has been adopted while the other half has been pigeon-holed, said Mr. McCobb. Pressure groups still find it easy to get appropriations through, and while in Michigan state government is functioning with 45 Boards there should be but two.

The Ledger has been giving some study to these numerous Boards, many of which seem to be overlapping in purpose and would necessarily mean wasteful spending in our state. We name a few from the up-to-date list of existing Bureaus, as follows:

ODM, Office Defense Mobilization; DMB, Defense Mobilization Board; OPA, Office Price Administration; NPA, National Production Authority; PAD, Petroleum Administration for Defense; SPAD, Solid Fuels Administration for Defense; DMA, Defense Materials Administration; OMF, Office Materials and Facilities; TNT, Total National Treasury; DSCR, Division Selective Credit Regulations; EPB, Emergency Procurement Service; MB, Munitions Board; FCDA, Federal Country Defense Administration; WMAQ, Woman's Munitions Administration Qualifications; DFA, Defense Production Administration; ESA, Economic Stabilization Agency; WSB, Wage Stabilization Board; DTA, Defense Transportation Administration; RFC, Reconstruction Finance Corporation; DFA, Defense Fisheries Administration; ORA, Office Requisitions Administration; PDQ, Production Defense Quartermaster; FDB, Food Distribution Branch; ICC, Interstate Commerce Commission; HHFA, Housing and Home Finance Agency; NSRB, National Security Resources Board.

It goes without saying that if Michigan can function with two boards instead of forty-five, then two boards are what the people want.
