### Poultry Hits Weekday Menu In More Homes

More consumers are buying poultry meat all through the week rather than just on weekends and holidays.

That's the belief of J. M. (Mac) Moore, extension poultry specialist at Michigan State University. He points out the results of research at the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station to back up his belief.

Maine researchers found that poultry meat is gradually overcoming its traditional use only on special occasions such as holidays and weekends. Stores were losing poultry sales by not having a complete line of poultry available to customers during the entire week.

The Maine study also showed that chicken is the biggest seller in the poultry products line. Eggs rank second with turkey coming in third.

Offering chicken in cut-up form seemed to be the best way to sell it, Moore points out. The researchers found that a whole bird packaged in cut-up form sold the best in the fresh eviscerated line. Fryers, too, sold best when cut-up and as parts. Giving consumers a chance to buy chicken parts helped boost poultry sales early in the week, the study showed.
