- Sweetened Sliced Peaches

Sift together flour and sugar. Cut or rub in shortening until mixture is crumbly. Combine egg and milk. Add to flour mixture, stirring until mixture is smooth. Turn into greased 9-in. pan. Bake in moderately hot oven (400° F.) about 25 minutes. Cut into wedges and slice each wedge into 2 equal layers. Fill and top with whipped cream and the peaches. Makes 6 servings.

### France Not So Gay, Says the McCarty Family

Their many Lowell friends will be very interested in a long letter which Mr. and Mrs. M. N. Henry recently received from Mrs. W. C. McCarty, upon her recent arrival in France. S/Sgt. McCarty expects to be stationed in France for three years, so his wife and six of their seven children recently enjoyed a very comfortable airplane trip to that European country, to make their home near their husband and father.

But, to this family which has moved many times to be near Sgt. McCarty, this isn't proving to be the most enjoyable spot in the world. The letter states that the weather is very rainy, and the housing is very inadequate. Mrs. McCarty expected to be able to set up housekeeping in a new government-provided housing area for Army personnel's families, but construction was not completed by September 1, as scheduled, so they are forced to live in a rented house in the French town neighboring the station. The children go to school by bus, leaving at 7:00 a. m. and arriving home after 5:00 p. m. The home is not furnished, and, as their belongings have not arrived, they are borrowing such as they can from other Army families. There is no central heating, and the homes are very damp, with inside walls 22 inches thick. Electric service is very unstable—they were without lights for 3 days at one time; and water comes from artesian wells, which water is pumped into storage tanks by windmills, and in the event of a calm day there just isn't a ny water.

Mrs. McCarty also states that the French are not as friendly as the Japanese were when they lived in that country. But she closed her letter in a lighter and more contented sounding vein. We quote: "The French bread is the only thing good about this country, and this is the day they bake here in the village; we are out so will be going after some in about 1 1/2 hours."

Sgt. McCarty is the son of Leon J. McCarty, South Washington st., and is a nephew of Mrs. Henry.

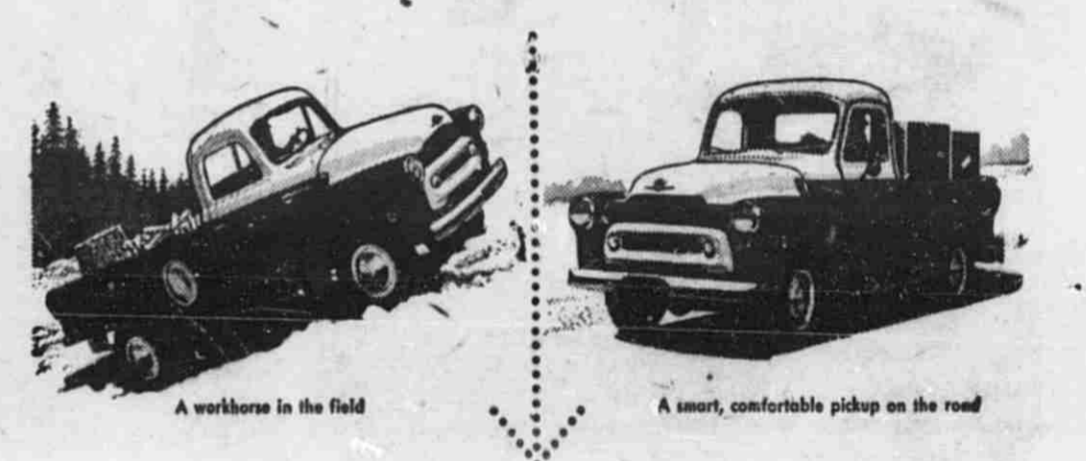
