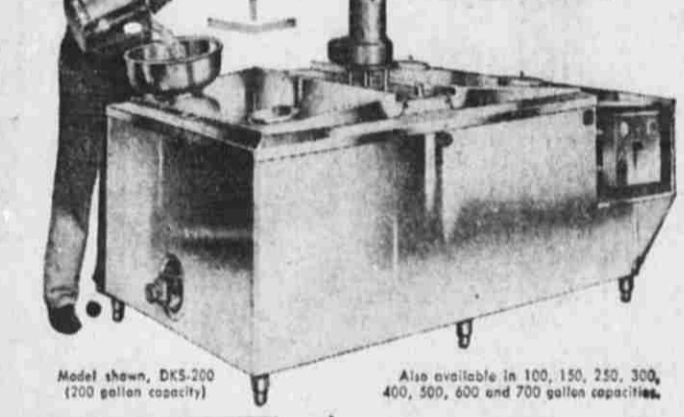

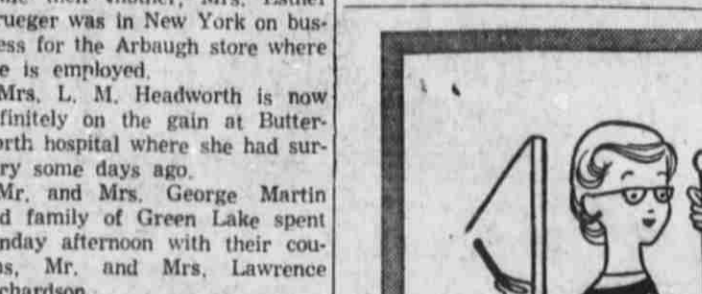

NEW MICHIGAN LAW, AMENDMENT PASSED IN 1956, REQUIRES:
 (Compiled Laws—168.361, Act 104A, Section 361) Townships, Annual Meetings, Time, Notice, Abolition — There shall be an annual meeting of the electors of each township on the Saturday preceding the first Monday in April of each year, between 1 o'clock and 8 o'clock p. m.; the time and place of such meeting shall be determined by the township board. The township clerk shall, at least 14 days but not more than 20 days before each such township meeting, post in at least 3 conspicuous places in each precinct and publish at least twice in a newspaper of general circulation in the township, a notice designating the date, time and place such meeting shall be held.
