I feel that an unfair interpretation could be placed on these circumstances. It is not right that any candidate gain his office in this way that anyone may say that he "backed into the job."

Car Seat Belts Can Save Lives... Seat belts cut in half the chance of injury in an auto accident; says Richard Pfister, Michigan State University farm safety engineer. Pfister says that seat belts reduce the chance of being killed by two-thirds.
