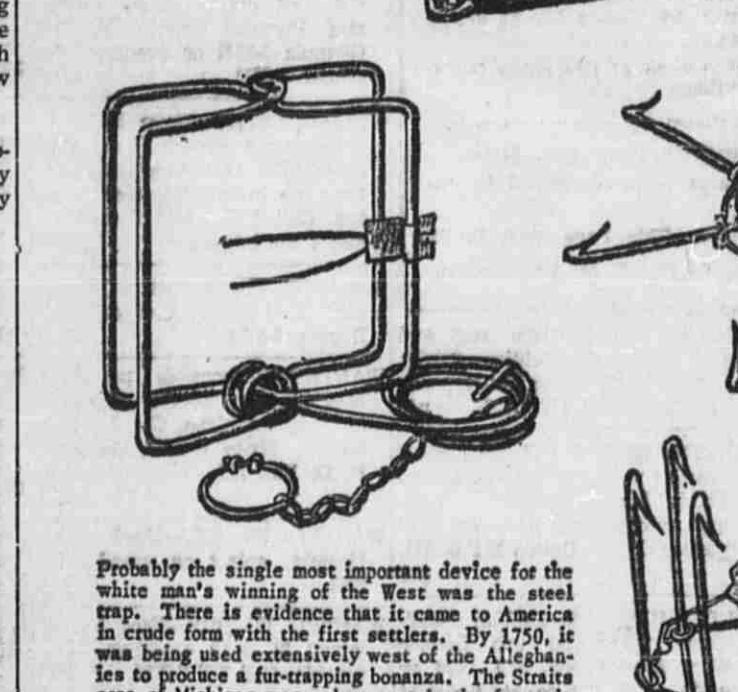

Accidental Poisoning Strikes Some 779 Kent County Children

A total of 779 cases of accidental poisonings to children in Kent County and Grand Rapids were reported to the Health Department in 1961 by the Poison Control Centers at Holland, St. Mary's and Butterworth hospitals.

Because reducing drugs are often used at mealtime, they are frequently and carelessly left on kitchen counters within children's reach.

Drugs and medicines should be kept in locked cabinets. Most children are capable of climbing on top of the bathroom sink, kitchen table or counter top to reach what may seem to be the most inaccessible shelves.

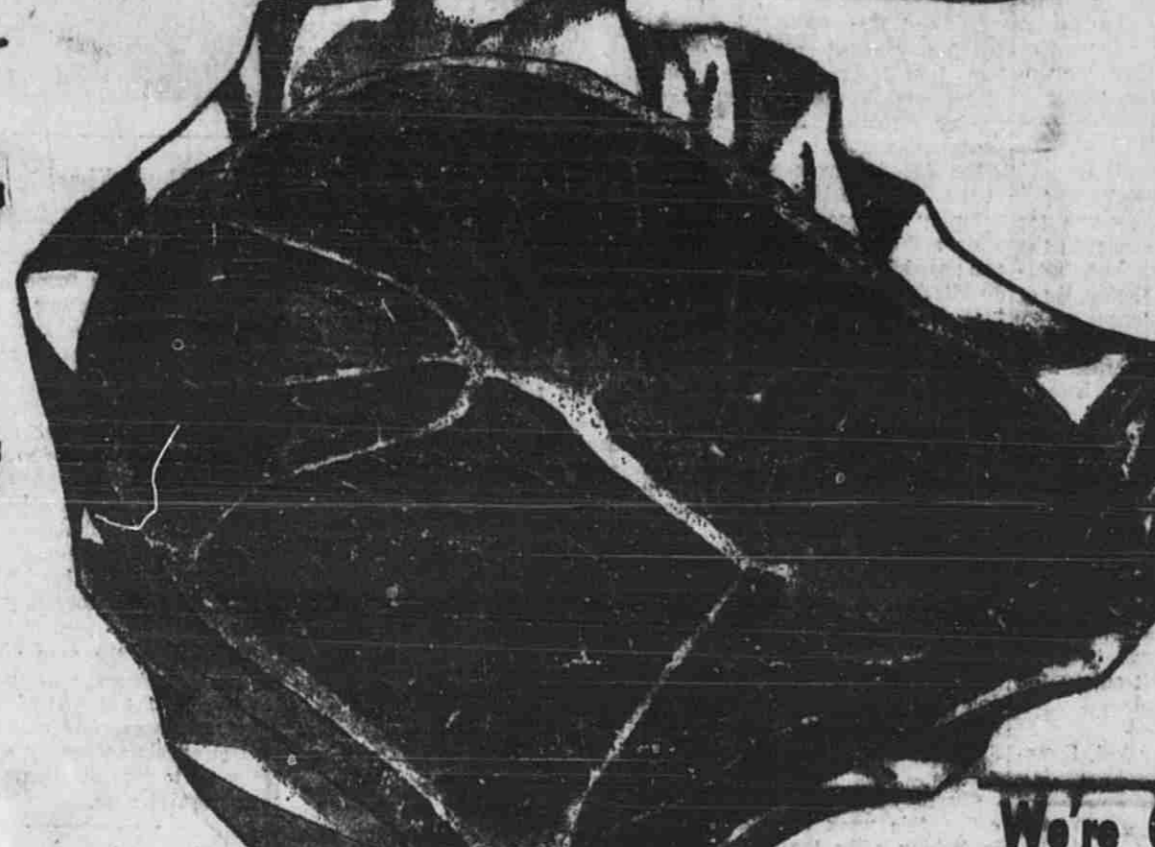

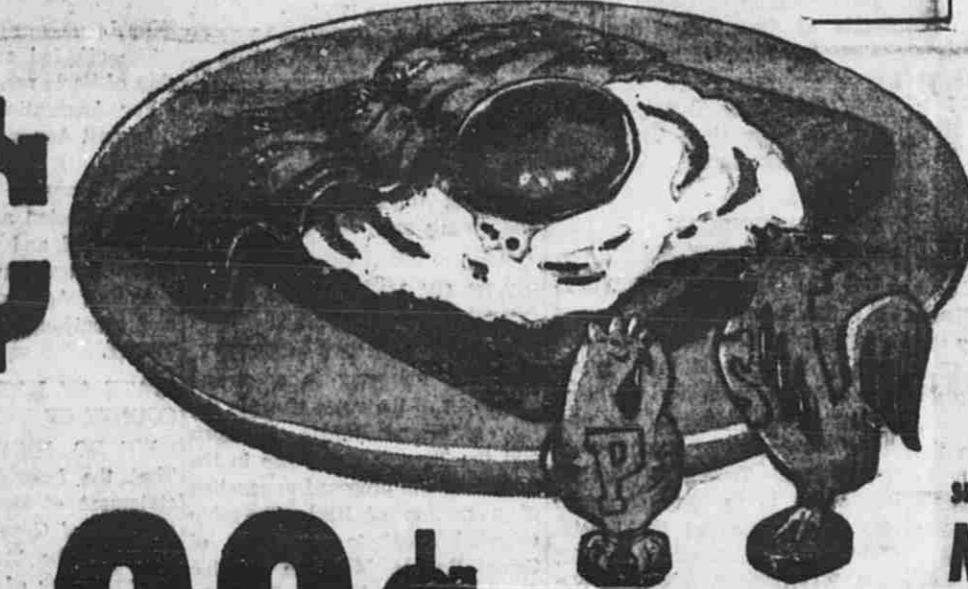

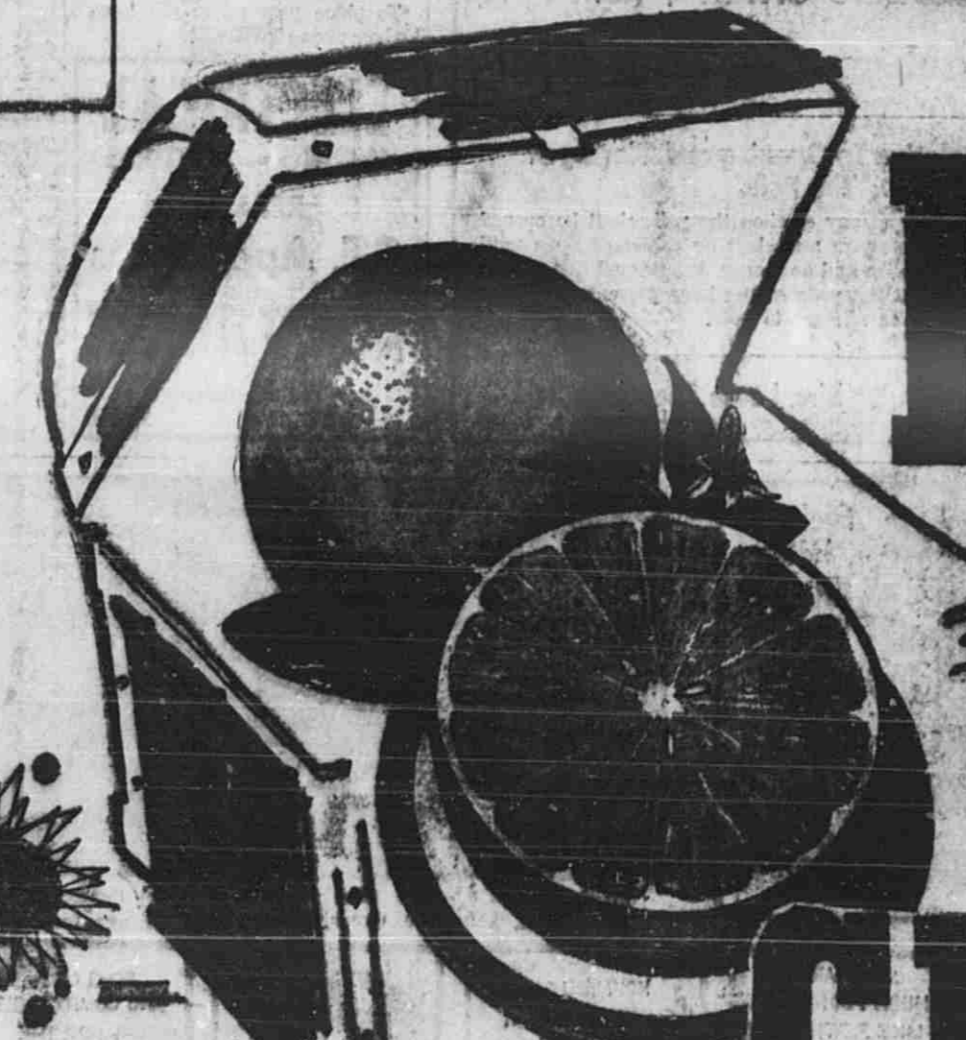
