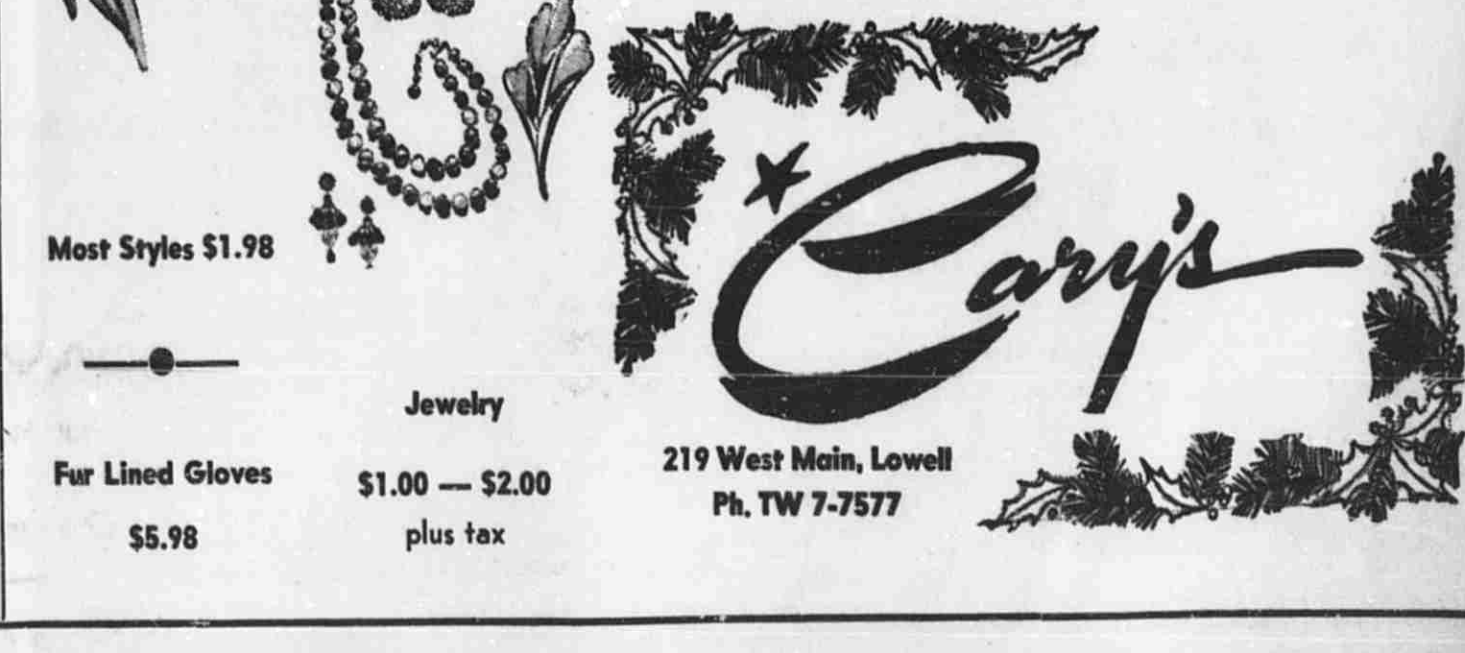

**1-96 Freeway Open Here To Detroit**



Michigan's rapidly expanding freeway system (double lines) is shown in this special map from Automobile Club of Michigan. The new 100-mile-long Detroit-Muskegon Freeway, I-96, contains the 1,000th mile of freeway in the state. Together with I-94, the Chicago Road, it connects eastern and western shores of Michigan. The \$1.1-billion I-96 runs up the center of the state, temporarily utilizing portions of US-25, US-10 and US-97. Also shown are the completed portions of other freeways, together with some of the other trunk highways (single lines).

Opening of the 1,000th mile of Michigan freeway on Wednesday (December 12) makes it possible for motorists to drive those thousand miles three times as safely, and in two-thirds the time required on the roads they replaced. Automobile Club of Michigan said today.

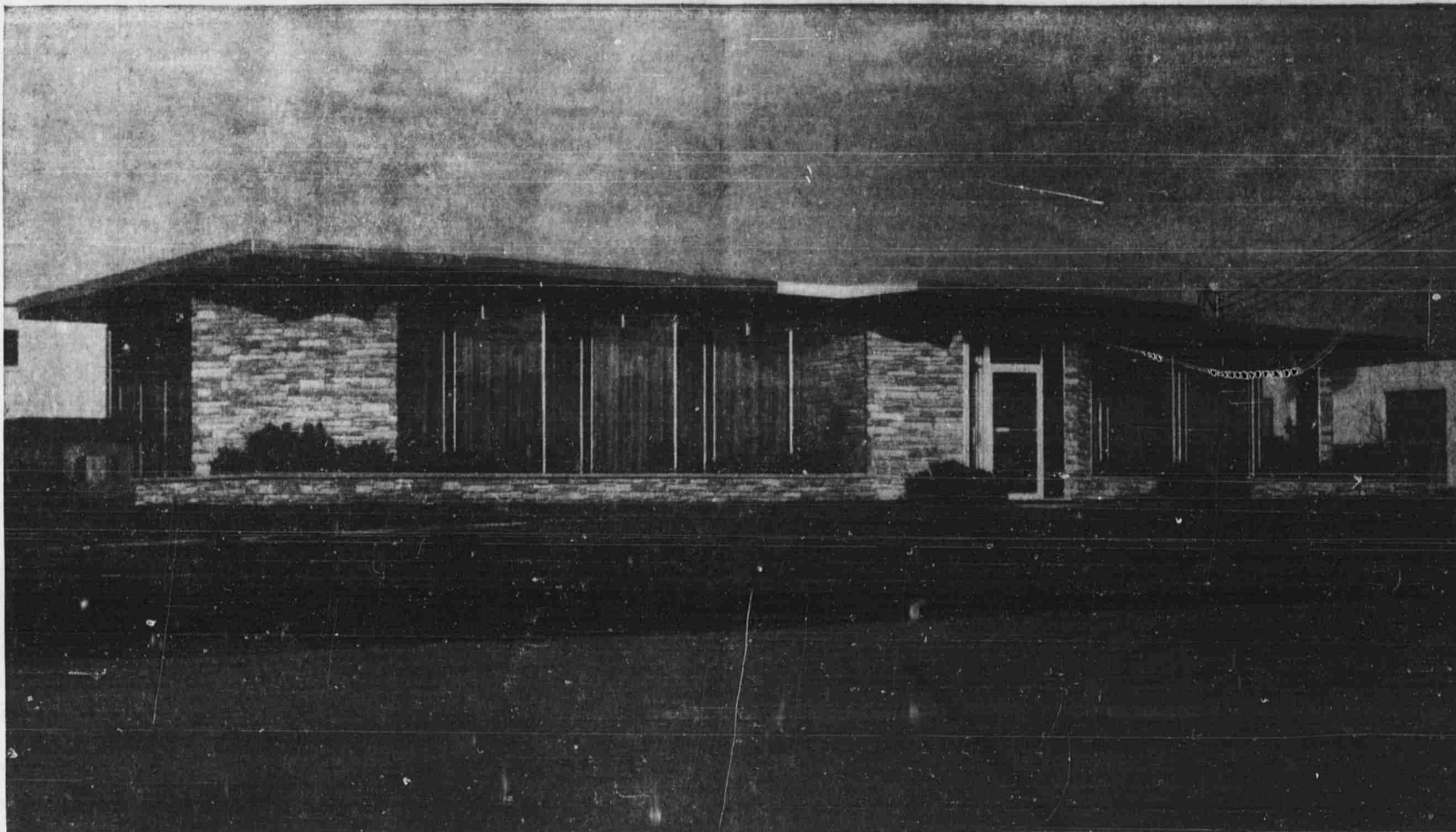
