What's cookin' in the eventh pin

German Apple Potato Salad
1/2 lb. bacon, diced
1 c. diced apples
5 potatoes cooked in jackets, 3/4 c.
1 onion
1/4 t. salt
1/4 t. pepper
1 t. sugar
1/2 c. vinegar
1 beaten egg

Fry bacon until crisp. Sprinkle a little sugar over the diced apples and saute in the bacon drippings until tender.

Combine bacon, apples, potatoes and onion. Add remaining ingredients to 2 tbsps. bacon drippings. Heat thoroughly. Pour over potato mixture and mix.

Vanilla Frosting
Place 1 c. sifted confectioners sugar, 1/2 tsp. butter or margarine, 1/4 tsp. salt, 1/4 cup milk in mixing bowl. Blend at lowest speed, then beat until smooth.

Add a little more milk, drop at a time, until of spreading consistency.

Tuna and rice are very nice, especially when they're combined in a pilaf style. Tuna pilaf is a quick, attractive family meal, high in nourishment and good taste.

Flavorful vegetables, sauteed in the tasty vegetable oil the tuna is packed in, add an appetizing touch of the pilaf.

Tuna Pilaf
2 cans (6 1/2 or 7 oz. each) tuna in vegetable oil
1 c. diced celery
One-third c. chopped onion
1 can sliced mushrooms
One-third c. diced pimiento
1 large green pepper, diced
3 c. cooked rice
1 tsp. salt
1/2 tsp. Accent
1/4 tsp. pepper
1 tsp. each, rosemary and marjoram

Drain oil from tuna into skillet. Add celery, onion and green pepper, cook until vegetables are crisp tender, about 3 minutes.

Add tuna, rice, pimiento and mushrooms with liquid and seasoning. Heat to serving temperature.
