The hand pump in the front yard still works if you need a drink, and the little house out back is a modern version of the long-ago two little houses out back.

Inside, see a realistic model of an 1860's village, go on to sadirons, bonecrusher, cobbler's bench, straight razor, coppertoed boots, and finish with tables of reasonably priced souvenirs, crafts and rummage.

All this is in the Fallasburg Schoolhouse Museum, across the Covered Bridge from Fallasburg Park. It is open from 1-5 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays from May to October, and from Saturday through Tuesday of the July Fourth weekend. Admission is free.

## Park on Bowes Road given an identity

Lowell's City Council approved the recommendation from Lowell's Parks and Recreation Commission to name the Bowes Road gravel pit park area Stoney Lakeside Park.

The decision follows a onemonth contest (May 1 through June 1) where residents were urged to send in entry forms with name suggestions for the "Name the Park Contest."

Suggestions submitted were based on various criteria, but were not limited to the following suggestions: historical, commemorative, community character and natural character.

The winning name for the park was a combination of two entries. They were submitted by Bev Homolka and the George Watson family. Homolka suggested Lowell Lakeside Park and the Watson family suggested Stoney Lake Park. The Park and Recreation Commission decided on Stoney Lakeside Park. Both Homolka and the Watson family will receive a framed letter of recognition from Mayor James Maatman and will have dedica-

#### ALLERGIES II

Last week we discussed allergic rhinitis and stated the treatment course of avoidance of allergy producing agents, immunotherapy and medications. In today's column we'll review the different medications available for relieving allergic rhinitis symptoms.

Antihistamines are widely used and are effective for providing symptomatic relief of allergies. They act by blocking the effect of histamine on the nasal tissue. Over the counter examples of antihistamines include Benadryl®, Chlortrimetron®, and others. Unfortunately, many antihistamines cause drowsiness, blurred vision, dry mouth, insomnia, and, in children hyperactivity. Two newer antihistamines are available by prescription which should not cause these side effects because the chemical does not cross into the brain.

Nasal decongestants are also widely available over the counter. They act by causing constriction of blood vessels in the nasal mucosa reducing swelling and stuffiness. Oral decongestants may cause nervousness and patients on blood pressure or heart medications should consult their doctor before regular use. Sudafed \* is a common over-the-counter decongestant. Topical decongestants (nasal sprays and drops) should be avoided because of their tendency to produce rebound congestion, which is often worse than the original congestion.

Nasalcrom® is a medication sprayed into the nose that prevents release of histamine from the special cells and therefore prevents symptoms and should be used throughout your allergic season.

Steroids are also used intranasally to prevent allergic symptoms. These products are effective and safe. They do not have the potent side effects that are associated with systemic (oral and injectable)

As you can see, there are many alternative medical regimens to bring your allergic symptoms under control.

While their radio show includes all of the morning time standbys of news, weather, sports and music, Rent and Sutton blend in a style of humor unique to the West Michigan market. The twosome shared some of the headlines with an area businessman from the previous week's news headline bit, e.g. "Mr. Rogers has started an assertiveness training class for men who never spit," dry pans Sutton. Rent, despite hearing it before, takes a step back to laugh. "I'm the laugher of the group. My laugh tells people it's okay to go ahead and laugh at / a.m., Rent says. I m not laughing just to laugh, but because I genuinely find what we're doing funny. However, what's funny is relative, that varies from person to person."

Success is also relative for both Sutton and Rent. While the West Michigan market is not big enough for many radio personalities, both Rent and Sutton are comfortable. "Nothing is forever. However, right now we are both very happy with where we're at and what we




