INGUINAL HERNIA

A hernia occurs when the intestine bulges through the muscular wall of the abdomen. Hernias most commonly are seen in the inguinal region--that space above the crease between the abdomen and thigh. Hernias can also occur in the upper thigh and around the belly button. The bulging intestine of an inguinal hernia may extend into the scrotum causing swelling of the scrotal sac. Inguinal hernias occur more commonly in men and in older individuals, although children may have them at birth.

Hernias are the result of straining the abdominal muscles. A small tear develops between the muscles, allowing the intestines to bulge through. This can be seen after lifting heavy objects or straining to have a bowel movement. Frequently the bulge can be reduced by pressing gently with the hand or lying on your back. Symptoms of an inguinal hernia include a noticeable bulge, pain, and a fullness at the site of herniation.

Surgery is usually the recommended therapy for most inguinal hernias. Complications can arise before surgery if you wait too long. If the intestine becomes entrapped outside the abdominal muscle wall, it is said to be an incarcerated

whernia. Incarcerated hernias cannot be reduced by simple pressure. Incarcerated hernias can cause blockage of intestinal flow leading to severe pain, bloating and vomiting. Strangulation of the hernia occurs when the hernia becomes swollen and tightly trapped, cutting off the blood supply to that portion of the intestine. Incarcerated or strangulated hernias need immediate surgical intervention. An infant with a hernia should be examined as soon as the hernia is noticed.


Most hernia surgeries are performed on an outpatient basis. The surgery is performed at the hospital the same day as admission and the patient is usually sent home later the same day. ITEM NO. 1. RENEWAL OF CONTRACT FOR AS-SESSMENT SERVICES. City Manager Pasquale said that the City has contracted for assessment services with James Marfia during the last three years. Pasquale stated that he was pleased with Mr. Marfia's performance, who is completing the reappraisal of all taxable properties within the City.

The new two year agreement proposed compensation at \$14,040 for 1991 (\$13,400 in 1990) and \$14,560 for 1991. All other provisions remained essentially the same. The new contract provided that payment be made every other week rather than twice a month.

Item No. 2. JOINT PURCHASE OF WOOD CHIPPER WITH LIGHT AND POWER. It has been proposed that the City and Light and Power jointly purchase a wood chipper to take care of disposing of brush. DPW Director Siciliano and LL&P Superintendent Haines suggested

chipper would be stored at the DPW garage with maintenance charges split by an hour meter.

The LL&P Board has approved half of the purchase (\$5,595.40) and recommended a waiver of the bid process because it is a highly proficient machine. Also, the City would be dealing directly with the factory which provides high government discount. The machine itself has an automatic feed, low maintenance, with factory 91. reconditioning and one day parts delivery.

The consensus of the Council was that the wood chipper should be purchased on a competitive bid process, in conformance with City policy. The issue was deferred until bids are received.

Item No. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF PRELIMINARY EN-GINEERING AND SURVEY COSTS FOR THE CHERRY CREEK DRAIN PROJECT. City Manager Pasquale said that in discussing the Cherry Creek drain project proposal with Barry Bittrick, Kent County Drain Commissioner, it was recommended that the Commission initiate preliminary engineering and surveying on Cherry Creek so that more accurate information can be gathered before the Determination hearing. The estimated cost for this work would be between \$1500 to \$2000. If a project is authorized, this would be rolled into the assessment cost. But, if it is not so determined, the City would be responsible to pick up these costs. It was mentioned that if the engineering and surveying on Cherry Creek is not done, the Drain Commission will have less accurate information at the Determination hearing.

IT WAS MOVED by Thompson and seconded by Hodges to authorize the preliminary engineering and survey costs for the Cherry Creek Drain project. YEA: 5.
