Land controversy cost school its operating millage; Lowell School District voters reject renewal by large margin

"The school district's challenge between now and August and September is to re-educate the Lowell Community as to what the purpose of this tax levy was," said a disappointed Lowell Superintendent, Fritz Esch.

The Lowell School Board and its leader learned Monday night that the Lowell School district voters overwhelmingly turned down a proposal to renew the operational millage of 27.5.

The vote was nearly 2-to-1 against the renewal. The unofficial total read like this: 815 voted "no" to renew the school millage and 424 registered voters said "yes" to the renewal.

Of the county allocated funds, the school district will receive 9.9395 mills of the 10.1 following the roll back to the Headlee Waiver. It will receive 4.85 from debt millage. Meanwhile, Monday night's vote will deny the school all of the 27.5 operational mills.

Lowell, which has projected a budget of \$14.98 million for the 1991-92 school year, will be left with just roughly \$4.8 million for operational expenses.

The school's Assistant Superintendent, Gary Kemp, said the school will be able to run up into September before being out of money and having to shut its doors provided the millage renewal is not approved in August or September whenever the school goes back to the public.

"There's no doubt that the controversy the school has been surrounded by with its pursuit of property for the new high school has had an impact on tonight's vote," Esch said. "I find it upsetting, although the school only has one choice and that is to come back to the district voters no later than September and no earlier than August." The school under law must wait 45 days before going to the ballot box again.

Esch said he anticipated having a struggle with the renewal vote, but nothing to the extent which surfaced Monday night.

A little less than 10 percent of the Lowell registered voters went to one of the three precincts to vote on Monday. School officials admitted that was a little lower than normal.


The rejection of the millage renewal marked the first time in Esch's nine years with the Lowell School District that a renewal did not pass. Esch also saw a vote for additional millage fail three years ago.

Also lost in the vote, was an extension of the 1.4 mills for energy and maintenance. The extension was supposed to be for two years. The current energy and maintenance fund expires in 1993.

While to a man, the board felt the current court case with Qua-Ke-Zik in regards to obtaining land was the main reason for millage denial, confusing ballot language and financial pressure brought on by the recession were also mentioned as possible reasons.

"I think the lack of understanding the requirements for the acquisition of new school property played a role," said Lowell School Board member, Ray Quada. "People may not realize it, but the school may have been in the same situation even had it not chosen the Qua-Ke-Zik property. Voters also need to understand that failure to renew this millage has nothing to do with the bond issue and our pursuit of property. Instead, tonight's vote had everything to do with being able to open the school's doors in September."

In 1951, Bud Howe, then the basketball coach at Lowell High School, informed a friend that Lowell was looking for a teacher and someone to coach football and crosscountry.

The young man, fresh out of Alma College, was interviewed for the job by W.W. Gumser and C.H. Runciman.

He was signed to a \$2,800 contract to teach and to coach three sports.

That same young man, Bob J. Perry, completed his 40th and final year at Lowell High School on Friday.

"You don't teach or coach for the money. You do it because you like working with kids," Perry said. "I've always been sincere and honest with students and I believe that has left me in positive standing with them. In the classroom and in the athletic arena, Perry has always set certain expectations for students and has encouraged them to attain their personal best.

I was a sophomore in Mr. Perry's biology class. I never applied myself real well which is why he had me sit in front of his desk. He always told me my next move would be out the door and down into the office. He assigned the class a project that year. I didn't do it. It got to be my junior year, my senior year, and then a couple of weeks before graduation Mr. Perry and Principal Nisbet (Steve) told me that I could go through the ceremony but I wouldn't be getting my diploma because I never completed the biology project.



I immediately recognized the voice as one of my college comrads, Diane Oleynik, an employee at Nissan over on the eastern side of the state.

She continued, "I've been up since 5:30. I was at work by 7 a.m. What are you doing?"

I was sleeping, but instead I responded, "Oh I've been up 10-15 minutes getting ready to go take pictures at the Children's Love Festival Parade. Being a farming community they always start at 8 a.m. here in Lowell."

Industrial Development: It may be a while before it reaches Lowell Twp.

The long range land use plan in Lowell Township for industrial development use continues to be a prickly and divisive topic among the township constituents and its plan-

"The Lowell Township Planning Commission will be making a decision on that very soon," said its member,

How soon, Lubbinge said was unclear. How desirable a light industrial development in the Lowell Township area is and where the location might be is also unclear.

Lubbinge clearly believes that, at this time, Lowell Township is not ready for such development. "Looking at it in the short term, I don't think the Township is ready for big industrial development. That may change next year," Lubbinge said. "The Township is struggling to provide water, sewer and streets for its constituents.

The planning commission member added that currently any industry developer looking to come into the township would have to provided water and sewer. "In most cases I think the developer would find that cost prohibitive," Lub-

He adds that at three meetings where light industry development has been discussed, 50-60 Township residents have been at the meetings and opposed the idea.

The detractors of light industry development are reluctant to surrender farm land. Lowell Township residents at the meetings have been adamant about protecting its farm land. Lubbinge maintains that unless it's a large developer there

will be little windfalls helping constituents with any taxes. That opinion is not shared by Lowell Township Supervisor John Timpson nor Planning Commission member Alyn

"If the school is in formula, then no, we will not receive any help as far as programs are concerned," Fletcher said.

The tired group arrived back into Lowell at 6:30AM, picked up their prizes and duffel bags and headed home to sleep or off to work.



He added, people should remember, Lowell schools will not always be in formula.

"The right kind of development, closely monitored by the planning commission, would help pay for capital expenditures," Timpson stresses. "Don't tell me the people in this because of the heavy tax load."

Other than helping to relieve some of the tax load, Timpson said, light industry development could also help finance the infra-structure to fund a sewage system for Segwun Village. 

POISON IVY SEASON

Late spring and early summer is the time of year when we see a greater number of patients with poison ivy dermatitis.

The poison ivy plant is found all over the United States . It

grows as ground shrubs of varying sizes or as vines affixing itself to trees, fences and other vines. The poison ivy plant is

easily recognized by its one leaf composed of three leaflets

The rash is due to an allergic reaction of the skin to the plant resin found in all parts of the plant - leaf, stem, roots and
