Lightning Strikes Twice

••• A bolt of lightning destroyed a storage barn at 2251 W. Main and a church steeple early Thursday morning

Bill Walters was awakened early Thursday morning by the sound of a lightning bolt striking a storage barn that sits in back of Donald and Donna Gerard''s house at 2251 W. Main St.

Walters, 80, who resides with Donald and Donna Gerard said he heard the crash and then everything shook.

"It was a terrible loud noise. The worst I've ever heard. It woke me up at around 5:15 a.m. Then I saw the fire," Walters said. "I wasn't sure if it had hit the house. I just wanted to get out of there."

Following the lightning strike, a fire ensued. With the telephone line dead, Walters drove to Crystal Flash where he called authorities and his grandson Phil Gerard.

Paul VanDyken, an employee at Family


The building, which was destroyed by the fire, was insured for \$16,800. Gerard said he had not determined the value of the contents inside, but estimated it to be at least \$10,000.

The Gerards, who have lived at 2251 W Main for 35 years, said the storage barn had been there at least 40-45 years.

Items stored in the barn included tools, a row boat, a boat trailer, household goods that belonged to Walters and a lawn mower belonging to the First Baptist Church of Lowell.

The Baptist Church also lost the top half of its steeple and its organ computer system was taken out in the electrical storm.

"My father-in-law lost a lot of sentimental stuff. Most of his valuable items are




A house that sits far off the road may not be seen, said Wise.

posted at the most visible part of the property access. She said residents can put up a pole or sign with house numbers, or paint them on a large stone. "Anything just as long as vehicles can see them at the point of entrance," she said.

Wise and the board want home owners to realize that having numbers near the road may not only assist the home owner, but their neighbors as well.

"If you have too many homes without numbers, there is no way an emergency vehicle can figure out where they need to go," said Wise. "If at least a couple of homes have numbers, then the vehicle will have a better idea of where they are at and need to go."


Two or four people can play. I suppose you could paint another set of washers for a third player. Duh... I hadn't thought of that before.

Navy Airman Adam C. Sherman, son of retired Air Force Maj. and Mrs. John P. Sherman of Alto, is currently halfway through a six-month overseas deployment with Strike Fighter Squadron 94 aboard the aircraft carrier USS Abraham Lincoln, which has included duty near Iraq in the Persian Gulf. Sherman is one of 5,000 Sailors and Marines who departed Naval Air Station Alameda, CA, in early April for the voyage to the Western Pacific and Indian oceans and Persian Gulf. So far, Sherman has traveled nearly 28,000 miles in the first three months.

Sherman's squadron is part of a seven-ship battle group which includes more than 80 tactical aircraft, and ships and submarines armed with Tomahawk cruise missiles. The battle group has the flexibility to deploy to separate geographic regions and can travel nearly 700 miles a day. During much of the deployment, Sherman and fellow battle group Sailors and Marines are assigned to the new U.S. Fifth Fleet, which is responsible for all U.S. naval operations from the Suez Canal to India, and as far south as Kenya.

Sherman's squadron, homeported at Naval Air Station Lemoore, CA, flies the F/A-18C Hornet, a twin-engine supersonic strike fighter capable of providing protection against enemy aircraft, delivering ordinance on targets ashore and at sea, and providing close air support for troops on the ground. Sherman's squadron also received the Battle "E" award for efficiency.

Sherman has been supporting the ongoing effort to enforce the no-fly zone over Southern Iraq. Aircraft from Sherman's squadron along with other squadrons have flown more than 800 missions over southern Iraq. In fact, USS Abraham Lincoln and its eight aircraft squadrons have conducted more than 3,800 aircraft launches and recoveries - half of them during the night. Sherman's unit also has been working in support of the ongoing maritime interception operations designed to prevent ships from smuggling prohibited materials to and from Iraq.

While most of the deployment has been at sea, Sherman also has had an opportunity to visit Hong Kong, Singapore and the United Arab Emirates. Not only did Sherman and fellow crew members go ashore to relax by taking tours and sightseeing, but more than 1,200 local people toured USS Abraham Lincoln during the port visits.

Sherman is now authorized to wear the Southwest Asia Service Medal for serving in the busy Persian Gulf area. Sherman's involvement in the deployment is an example of how Sailors and Marines are serving aboard aircraft carriers, ships, submarines, squadrons and shore stations around the world in support of U.S. interests.
