Nothing alarming found in city audits

If the audits of accounts and records for the city of Lowell, Lowell Light and Power and Lowell Cable Television were chili, there would be no "alarm" disclaimers.

In fact, the audits prepared by the firm of Biggs. Hausserman, Thompson and Dickenson P.C. would all be considered pretty bland.

The city of Lowell's audit showed the general revenue was up 2.6 percent or \$43,000 (from approximately \$1.6 to \$1.7 million).

Also rising slightly were state shared revenue (by a couple of percentage points) and property tax (by one percent).

Thomas Dickinson, CPA, said these were all in line with past years.

One item that did draw attention to itself is the expenditure ledger in which an increase of 11 percent or \$165,000 was incurred.

"This was due to sidewalk construction and the purchase of fire and police equipment." Dickinson said.

The fund balance of \$718,512 continues to represent 10-15 percent of the total budget.

Of that total, \$130,000 of the reserve is set aside for vacation and sick pay.

The audit also shows that \$100,000 was transferred from the equity fund to help in the financing of the downtown water main.

Dickinson also pointed out that the city of Lowell's building and site fund has been reduced to a nominal amount. He recommended the balance of approximately \$1,700 be transferred to the building

authority or general fund. The building and site fund could then be terminated.

The Frank L. Carr Fund and the Lee Fund are both trust funds held by the city of Lowell for the benefit of city residents.

The funds have no adopted policy to allow these funds to grow through retaining a portion of their annual fund balance.

Dickinson suggested that the city council adopt a policy for these two funds which would be similar to the policy adopted by the Look-Daley Fund. The Look-Daley policy reserves 15 percent of the annual income in the fund balance.

With an investment base of \$2.6 million, the Lowell Light and Power investment fund remains quite healthy.

Virgil Biggs, CPA, said in order to realize the maximum return on these funds, it is important that cash be analyzed frequently so that a balance between short-term, mid-term and long-term investments can be maintained.

Lowell Light and Power's net income for the year ending 1996 was \$344,753, up \$123,990 from 1995.

"The most significant factor in the increase in net income was a reduction in purchase power costs of \$125,174," Biggs said.

The interest income for the year was \$157,172 compared to \$133,770 a year ago.

In 1992, the profit spread was \$756,000. Four years later, the profit margin now stands at over \$1 million.

Biggs suggested that the city revisit the \$600,000 re-

Sports club reaches agreement with township board regarding facility upgrades

Lowell Charter Township officials have received word from the Northeastern Sportsman's Club that the organization will meet the guidelines set by the township board to keep its facility operating.

The board gave the club a list of 10 guidelines that must be met to continue its operation on Grand River Drive.

Besides installing a privacy fence, a gate that locks and a commercial driveway, and informing the township board of the club's governing body, the organization must clean up its septic system to meet Kent County Health Department codes.

The septic system violation was the most serious found at

the club, which has occupied the same location on more than 43 acres of land since 1960.

The club will operate as a "rustic" campground until the septic system has been cleaned up, according to township supervisor John Timpson.

Members of the club pay an annual fee to store their camper trailers during the winter and visit them during the summer.

The club existed before zoning came to the township, but a review was prompted when the township began receiving complaints from neighbors of the club.

Residents' number one complaint was of people asking to use their phones during late evening hours.

If the club meets all of the township's guidelines, it will receive a special use permit.

In the past, Timpson said the club has shown good intentions of working with the board and neighbors regarding the new rules.

Timpson said the club's existence meets the use of the land and doesn't believe further problems will arise.

Shovelers should beware of heart rate and blood pressure

January can be a winter wonderland, except when it comes to snow shoveling. The Safety Council for West Michigan offers the following suggestions to make shoveling safer and more enjoyable this winter:

Individuals 40 years of age or older should be careful, especially those who are relatively inactive. If you have a history of heart trouble, do not shovel

without your doctor's permission.

Take it slow! Shoveling can raise your heart rate and blood pressure dramatically. Be sure to stretch out and warm up before you start.

Shovel snow while it is fresh. Fresh snow is easier to shovel than wet, packed down snow.

Push the snow as you shovel. It is better for your back than lifting the snow out of the way. Don't pick up too much at once. Use a small shovel, or fill

only one -fourth or one-half of a large one. Lift with your legs bent and your back straight. By bending and "sitting" into the movement, you'll place less stress on your spine and lower back. Let your shoulders, torso

and thighs do the work for you. Never work to the point of exhaustion. If you run out of breath, take a break. If you feel any tightness in your chest, stop immediately.

Dress warmly. Remember that extremities, such as the nose, ears, hands and feet need extra attention during winter's cold. Be sure to wear head and face protection, mittens, wool socks and waterproof boots.







DEAR JONATHAN: About six months ago I updated my will and trust and at the same time implemented a health care power of attorney and a living will. It is my understanding that I can also execute a do-not-resuscitate order. Is this true and if so, what procedures must be followed?

JONATHAN SAYS: Yes, Michigan has a "do-not-resuscitate procedure act" which became effective August 1, 1996. This act only authorizes do-not-resuscitate orders (DNR orders) in a setting outside of a hospital, a nursing home, or a mental health facility owned or operated by the department of community health. Pursuant to this act, an individual 18 years of age or older and of sound mind may execute a DNR order on his or her own behalf.

Also, assuming the appropriate language has been included in a durable power of attorney for health care, the patient advocate named in that document may also execute a DNR order on behalf of the individual, who is 18 years of age or older and of sound mind at the time he or she executed that docu-

Some of the other procedural requirements include the following:

1. The language to be used in a DNR order must be substantially the same as indicated on the form provided by the

2. The DNR order needs to be dated and executed voluntarily by the following persons:

(a) The declarant (or person acting on behalf of the declarant who has executed the DNR order in the presence of the declarant).

(b) The declarant's attending physician.

(c) Two witnesses who are 18 years of age or older. At least one of the witnesses cannot be an individual who is the declarant's spouse, parent, child, grandchild, sibling or presumptive heir.

The person who signs the DNR order must maintain the document in his or her possession and have it accessible.

In addition, the declarant may wear a DNR identification

bracelet containing that information required by the statute. A DNR order may be revoked at any time by the declarant or the patient advocate who executed a DNR order on the declarant's behalf, in any manner by which he or she is able to communicate an intent to revoke the DNR order.

Assuming all of the procedural requirements have been met and a health professional determines that the declarant has no vital signs and further determines that there is a DNR order in existence on behalf of the declarant, then the health professional is prohibited from attempting to resuscitate the declarant. Further, that health professional shall not be subject to civil or criminal liability for failing to attempt to resuscitate the

Under the statute, a health professional is defined as a paramedic, an emergency medical technician, an emergency medical technician specialist, a physician, a nurse, a medical first responder or a respiratory therapist.

Finally, there are two different forms of DNR orders allowed under the statute. The first one is for people who use a physician. The second one is for individuals who rely on spiritual healing through prayer.



SCOLIOSIS

Scoliosis is a lateral curvature of the spine and is considered significant only if it is greater than 10 degrees. Many efforts have been established to identify scoliosis at an early age, especially in young females. School based screening, while well intended, does a less than adequate job of detecting significant cases of scoliosis. Early detection is crucial since treatment is much more effective when begun at an early age.

Parents may be the first to notice a curvature in the spine. A significant scoliosis may result in one shoulder being lower than the other. In most instances, the curvature is picked up at the time of a routine checkup or a sports physical in the office of the primary care physician.

In most cases, scoliosis is mild in degree and causes no problems. If, however, the degree of spinal curvature increases with time, or causes symptoms, bracing may be needed. If bracing is not sufficient to retard the progression, or if pain and decreased range of motion persist, surgery may be needed. As with many screening programs in the adolescent years, early detection and evaluation of scoliosis is paramount.

serve used for future equipment replacement so that inflation can be factored in.

Lowell Light and Power agreed to purchase and install the street lighting in connection with the Downtown Development Authority project. The amount of the commitment is estimated to be \$200,000.

The cost of the project will be treated as a transfer to the Downtown Development Authority and will result in a reduction in net income to Lowell Light and Power in the amount of the transfer for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1997. "The Lowell Light and Power profits will decline due to this transfer." Biggs explained.

Lowell Light and Power sales trends show that residential sales have remained pretty flat over the last four years.

Commercial sales trends showed a slight increase up through 1995, but then dipped a little in 1996.

Public authority has seen a decline in revenue from 1993 to 1996.



Lowell Cable's gross profit percentage (the difference between the program costs and selling price for basic service) declined to 73.8 percent from 78.4 percent.

This is due to the increase in program costs, which consists of an increase in the number of channels as well as the costs per channel.

Between debt retirement and new assets purchased to keep the Lowell Cable system upgraded, there is about \$200,000 needed every year.

The audit report showed the basic cable count at 2,186. This is up 101 from 1995 and 183 over the last two years.

Premium channel subscriber count is down four from 1995 and 47 from 1994.

While basic service gross revenue was \$490,721, up \$35,105 from 1995, Lowell Cable's net income declined to a four-year low of \$69,845.

Operating expenses increased \$55,944 which were partially offset by revenues which increased by \$33,500.

The average monthly cost to Lowell Cable television for basic service programs was \$3.23 in 1994. It was \$5.00 in 1996. Of the one dollar rate increase in May, 97 percent of it is consumed in direct payments for basic service channels.

Biggs said program costs should be monitored closely. "Continued increases in costs may require a rate adjustment to avoid significant declines in operating income."

The policy of late fee charges, Biggs said, appears to be working. Late fee charges added \$23,905 to revenue this year.

Finally, the aggressive debt service policy has reduced the note payable to Lowell Light and Power by \$156, 668 over the last two years. The balance is \$397,877 and is scheduled to be paid in full in July of 2000.







Cornerstone makes decision to discontinue aviation programs at Lowell City Airport

Cornerstone College's airplane flight training and maintenance programs will be terminated in May and August respectively.

Cornerstone's maintenance program will continue until August because that is when school financing for the program

"Cornerstone will continue with its aviation program through contracting out services with vendors," said Robert Mol, Cornerstone's vice president for business.

The college's aviation program at the Lowell City Airport is being discontinued due to economic concerns. "Cornerstone cannot come up with sufficient funding to run the programs," Mol said.

Cornerstone signed an agreement with Grand Rapids Bible College in 1993 to take over aviation programs when it merged with the Grand Rapids Baptist Academy.

Carl Francis, director of aviation services for Cornerstone, and several other Cornerstone employees will lose their jobs. However, they are interested in finding a way to form their own aviation program.

Lowell city manager Dave Pasquale said they are in the early stages of putting together such a plan.

The city of Lowell has an interest in seeing the program

continued. Approximately \$40,000 in loans from the state for two additional hangars came in 1992 with the stipulation that the city operate an airport until 2012.

Mol said the college's decision is not a reflection on the city. "Lowell has been a great host and we have tried to be good stewards of the airport."

City extends Endless Lawn Service and Nursery contract

The city of Lowell agreed to a two-year extension of its lawn maintenance contract with Endless Lawn Service and Nursery of Alto.

It has provided the city with lawn maintenance to its nine properties since 1994.

The current contract carries through until next year. The extension will continue the contract to 1999 with no cost

WLAV listeners find Gates relatable and passionate about their music



"We are playing music they grew up with in the 60's and 70's," Gates explains. "It's well made music. It appeals to all generations."

Ironically, Gates' first commercial radio job out of college (Grand Valley State) was with WLAV in 1973.

Gates was hired for the

album promotion director.

"I was given a list of artists. It was my job to make sure the artists were getting played," Gates said. He promoted the likes of Michael Penn, Bruce Hornsby and ZZ. Top.

After 10 years with RCA in Los Angeles, music began to change and with it came the onset of "grunge."

"It's an aggressive, progressive music," said Terri Crayton, WLAV's marketing consultant for Harold Zeigler Ford.

Gates calls it angry youth music. "I was being asked to promote music that I didn't like being played by 18-20 year olds," he said. "It wasn't fun, so I got out of it."

That brought Gates back to West Michigan and back to playing and promoting music he has a passion for music he likes.

"I don't like to pigeonhole the music as classic rock," Gates said.

He is comfortable, though, labeling it as music that has a message which has stood the test of time... unlike most of the music being produced today.

"Most of the music today will not be a factor five years from now," Gates said. "The music you and I grew up with was such a fabric of people's lives. People tried to end wars with their music. It was in the forefront."

Gates notes that there are incredible musicians out there. "Many of them can't get their foot in the door," he explains. "Years ago, musicians signed contracts to do three-four albums. Today, they get one shot; if the album is not a success, they are done."

As long as the market place shadows Gates' passion (music from the 60's and 70's), there will be a pedestal in West Michigan for Gates to play it from.


