Schematic design for City Hall renovation approved by Lowell City Council

The Lowell City Council took a major step forward in renovating City Hall.

The council voted unanimously to approve the schematic

design presented by Dan Durkee of Fishbeck, Thompson, Carr, and Huber as the development plan outline for the proposed renovation project of City Hall. By doing so, the council has set the wheels in motion for city officials to begin pursuing property acquisition and organizing the financing efforts for the project.

During his 15-minute presentation, Durkee went over the year-long process in putting together the schematic design, which included two public meetings, meetings with the Historical District and Downtown Development Authority, and several interviews and meetings with city officials and staff.

"We looked at everything from the city manager office to

the janitorial closets," Durkee said.

From those meetings, Durkee said his design firm determined that the city was using 6,250 gross square feet. On an estimated project of 25 years out, the city would need to triple the amount of space to about 19,970 square feet.

Further discussions revealed an emotional attachment to the current City Hall with many residents "identifying with this building," he said. Renovating the current City Hall and adding an addition also proved to be an economical move as well, Durkee said.

In the schematic design plan, it is recommended that an addition be made to the back of the building to house the police department. A new entrance would be created to connect the old building to the new portion, which would be designed to echo the original building's style.

The parking lot to the north of the building would be eliminated, which would force the city to have to acquire property further to the north for a new parking lot. A resident raised concern about the city eliminating the playground, which would be near the new proposed parking lot. City officials and Durkee said the city hoped to gain a small portion of the playground, but for the most part it would be left undisturbed.

"This is the first big step with many more to come," said city manager David Pasquale.

What's best may not be most expedient and what's most expedient may not be what's best.

Sound like a riddle? It's not. It is the dilemma facing the proposed Bieri Industrial Park.

Ideally, Rich Bieri, developer, and project engineer Ray Zandstra would like public sewer and water for Bieri's 80-acre industrial park.

Vergennes Township learned that while the city of Lowell is interested in discussions, its wastewater plant is near capacity and a utility study is in the process of being completed to determine the necessity for plant expansion.

Its unavailability led Bieri's attorney, C. Blair Mohney, and Zandstra to propose a community sewer/septic whereby each of the 14 lots would have two tanks.

The second tank would pump waste into a commercial drain field area. The projected cost for the community sewer/septic (\$250,000) would be close to that of hooking up to public utilities.

While a community septic/sewer could be done now, it is unclear as to when public utilities will be available.

James Hegarty, Vergennes Township engineer, said it would be a shame to have a public utilities so close without giving a "college effort" to get it in the industrial park (at the end of Godfrey Street).

A. Southeast corner of Sibley and Ridgeview - Michael Nosko - Maplewood Square (Phase I) - construction of two fourplex apartments - setback variance from Ridgeview- public hearing Michael Nosko proposed the construction of two fourplex apartments at the southeast corner of Sibley and Ridgeview. After reviewing the criteria for granting variances, the Planning Commission, at its October 26, 1998 meeting, recommended to the Zoning Board of Appeals approval of Maplewood Square Development (Phase 1) allowing a twenty foot setback from Ridgeview Drive where thirty feet is required.

Councilmember Myers questioned if there was discussion concerning a 20 foot setback from Ridgeview causing vision problems when traveling around the corner. Commissioner Hall stated the Commission did not believe this would be a problem.

The new Light and Power Superintendent Ron Holcomb would have supervision of Director of Cable TV Services Thomas Richards. City Manager Pasquale would have direct involvement.

During this time, all three will meet weekly, to keep each other informed. Within one year, a final proposal for operation will be determined as to how each will be involved. Also, these guidelines would be added to all three job descriptions. The Light and Power and Cable TV Boards will also be asked to adopt these guidelines.

IT WAS MOVED BY SHORES and seconded by MYERS to adopt the letter of understanding for the management of Cable TV Department as submitted.

Item #4. PRESENTATION OF THE ICE SKATING FA-CILITIES FEASIBILITY STUDY. City Manager Pasquale stated the Look Memorial Fund Committee, during its May 20, 1998 meeting, approved up to \$4,100 for an Ice Skating Facilities Feasibility Study. He noted Bruce Walter had approached the Council at the February 17, 1998, meeting regarding City assistance for the creation of an outdoor area or arena.

Design Plus Inc. of Grand Rapids was contracted to conduct the study. Options were reviewed for both indoor and outdoor facilities, providing information regarding construction costs.

Wayne Norlin of Design Plus stated the initial cost of the project (outdoor or indoor) would be approximately \$500,000 - \$600,000. Design Plus provided the following options for review.

- A study was completed on the Foreman Building. Design Plus determined this building would not be suitable for a rink, unless an addition was built. Norlin also noted: a) the building is located in the floodplain, b) would be too small for hockey or figure skating, and c) does not provide space for equipment, locker rooms, concession stand, restrooms and observers.

 A study was undertaken for an outdoor skating facility. Design Plus presented the following issues for an outdoor rink: a) the ice would only be usable for skating when NAY: 0 the temperature was below 40 - 45°, b) solar gain and ABSENT: 0. wind create problems, and c) operation of an outdoor ice MOTION CARRIED

The study provided a proposed rink large enough for competitive figure skating and hockey. The approximate cost would be between 1.8 million to 3 million

Norlin mentioned it may be wise to consider combining a swimming pool and ice skating rink together under one building. He stated one article of equipment could heat the pool and keep the ice frozen, at the same time.

Norlin stated Stoney Lakeside and Creekside Parks would be good locations for either a swimming pool or an ice rink. These locations would not be large enough to hold both. He noted there is abundant space for a pool and rink if the facility was built across from the Lowell High School on Vergennes Road, which is owned by Lowell Area Schools.

Perry Beachum of 924 Riverside Dr. questioned if Design Plus had an approximate dollar amount of how much it would cost to operate such a facility. Norlin stated Design Plus had inquired to several facilities in the Grand Rapids area, but were unable to receive an answer.

City Manager Pasquale stated the City can use this study as a guide. He noted more information will be needed to make a final decision.

Item #5. BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS COMPENSA-TION STUDY. As directed by City Council, City Manager Pasquale conducted a survey to determine what neighboring communities have compensated their appointed boards and commissions. Currently, the City compensates the following boards:

Board of Review \$10 per hour

(\$325 maximum)

A survey was presented which outlined compensation for twelve West Michigan communities.

Mayor Thompson asked what steps should be taken for the boards and commissions to be compensated. City Manager Pasquale responded the Planning Commission would need a charter amendment: This would have to be included on the November, 1999 City election ballot. Pasquale would have to review requirements for other boards and commissions

Councilmember Myers stated he had requested this information because the Planning Commission currently does not receive any compensation. Myers believed the Commission invests much time and should be compensated for their services.

IT WAS MOVED BY MYERS and seconded by SHORES to include in the November 1999 City election the consideration, as part of the charter revision review, a section addressing the boards and commissions compensation.

Biggs said the city should be quite proud of its staff who, even through a transition year with different heads leaving, was able to maintain good financial records.
"They do an excellent job

in record keeping," he said.




